RE Incorporation of the Town of Big Thicket

Dear Judge Thompson


Enclosed please find an application for incorporation of the Town of Big Thicket, which is in the form of a petition signed by approximately seventy-eight legally qualified voters who reside within the proposed municipality. Attached to the application is a plat showing the boundaries of the proposed City of Big Thicket Village. The residents who signed the petition respectfully request that you call an election for May 6th of this year so that they may vote on whether or not to incorporate this area.

Enclosed for your convenience is a proposed Order of Election regarding the incorporation and election of the first city council, should the incorporation measure pass. Before calling the election you need to determine that the application for incorporation has the signatures of fifty or more qualified voters, that the proposed municipality will contain at least six hundred inhabitants, and that the proposed municipality is not more than two square miles in size. We will provide, through either live testimony or affidavits, proof as to the population and size of the proposed municipality. Proof of the voter registration of the people who signed the petition can be determined by the registration number they put on the petition.

Also enclosed please find a procedure checklist for the County Clerk to use in preparing for this election, a proposed election schedule, a sample ballot to assist the County Clerk in preparing the ballot for this election, and an application form for council candidates to use.

Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions concerning the proposed incorporation of Big Thicket Village.

BOUNDARIES OF BIG THICKET VILLAGE

Beginning at a point located in the east right-of way line of State Highway # 146 which coincides with the northwest corner of Section 20 of the Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision,

Thence southward along the East right-of way line of State Highway # 146 to a point which coincides with the southwest corner of Lot 99, Section 4 of the Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision,

Thence following the southern most property line of the above described Lot 99 to its southeast corner, and proceeding along the eastern most boundary line of Lot 99 through the eastern most boundary lines of Lots 100 through 122 of Section 4 of the Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision to a point in the northeast corner of said Lot 122,

Thence eastward along the southern most boundary line of Lot 123 Section 4 of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision to the southeastern corner of said Lot 123, then continuing northward along the eastern most boundaries of Lot 123 Section 4 of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision and northward across the right of way of Gordon Glen and following the east right of way line of the cul de sac of Gordon Glen along the western property line of Lots 12, 11, 10, and 9 of Section 4 of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision to a point which is the intersection of right of way line of the cul de sac Gordon Glen the southwest corner of the above described Lot 9, and the southeast corner of Lot 8 Section 4 of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision,

Hence northeastward along the boundary line between the above described Lots 8 and 9 and extending across Menard Creek to a point 200 feet south of Armadillo Avenue which coincides with an extension of the east right of way line of Flamingo Lane,

Then eastwest parallel to and 200 feet south of the south right of way line of Armadillo Avenue to a point 75 feet from the west right of way line of Love Drive,

Then in a southerly, then easterly direction along a line 75 feet east and south of, and parallel to the west and south right of way line of Love Drive, until such line intersects the west property line of Lot 47 of Section 13, Big Thicket Lake Estates,

Then southward along the west property line of the above described Lot 47 and the adjacent Lot 48 to a point which intersects the east bank of Menard Creek,

Then southward along the meanders of the east bank of Menard Creek to a point at which said bank intersects with the southeastern most corner of Lot 81 of Section 13 of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision,

Thence eastward along the property line between Lots 456 and 457 of Section 18 and Lots 386 and 387 of Section 19, both of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision, to a point where the southeast corner of the above described Lot 457 and the northeast corner of the above described Lot 387 coincide,

Thence northward along the eastern most boundary line of Section 18, Section 17, Section 16, and Section 6, all of Big Thicket Lake Estate Subdivision, to a point which is the most northeasterly point of the above described Section 6,



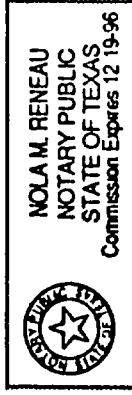



WHEREAS, The Southeast Texas Regional Task Force on Transportation has examined the impact on our area from the Hurricane Andrew, August, 1992, evacuation, and the implementation of the federal legislation entitled The Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA), and the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) and said Task Force has produced a report entitled "Southeast Texas Intermodal Transportation Plan" dated February 1, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the study has identified insufficient capacities on evacuation routes, inadequate north-south access through Southeast Texas, the need for funding for the I-69 corridor (Existing U S Hwy 59), and a Southeast Texas connection from Lufkin to Beaumont along proposed U S. Highway 69 and the need to strengthen the intermodal elements of rail, highway, and ports to meet the objectives of the "ISTEA" legislation; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Texas Region will benefit from the implementation of said Intermodal Transportation Plan and need to work harmoniously with the Texas Department of Transportation in support of the Gulf Coast Hurricane Evacuation Plan, its proposed plan for U S Highway 69 to utilize the Southern Pacific Railroad to be abandoned, and other transportation projects that will create and support economic growth and development in the future; now, therefore,


### BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT the Texas Transportation Commission be requested to implement the Texas Hurricane Evacuation Task Force recommendations, and to provide a special fund for this category, and to prioritize funding for the I-69 corridor (existing U. S. Highway 59) through East Texas, and to provide a connection to the I-69 corridor from Lufkin to Beaumont; and

THAT the Counties, Cities, Port Districts, Chambers of Commerce and other entities by approval of this Resolution do agree to work in a united effort for the completion of the requested work by being represented in Austin, Texas before the Texas Transportation Commission in March, 1995, and each year or more often thereafter to continue the united support of this requested work until completed.

THAT a copy of this Resolution be provided the Task Force for presentation to the Texas Transportation Commission.
