Judge Thompson Commissioner's Court Ladies & Gentlemen

First, I wish to clear up a matter from Monday Morning court.
Mr. Fogleman, said "There was one name on my Monday List of
Judges, that had Moved from the county & changed their voting
registration from Polk County to another one." That person he
was referring to was Elaine Stephens, Box#12-Indian Village, that
worked as an alternate last November in the Amendment Election.
She and her husband have moved, but they are still registered
in Polk County Voter Registration records.

The article in yesterday's newspaper, just had a couple of misconceptions. Mr. Fogleman said "He was prepared to file a law suit with the Justice Department, and contact the Secretary of State, if the Commission's court, voted to approve my first list of election judges.

The "Mistake" I made, was not putting it in writing what I expected each party chairman's responsibility in training procedeures. In the near future, I plan on making a request in Commissioner's Court to "ADOPT", certain training standards for ALL election judges and alternates, for all future elections. According to Texas Election Code, Subchapter F. "Training" Sec 32.111 & 32.114 & 32.115, "The Commissioner's court may adopt "Minimum Standards of training in election law and procedure for presiding or alternate judges serving in its elections " (I have attached a copy of the pages) It is within the scope of my duties as County Clerk, to request this action. I also, plan to have a training session at the time the Election Boxes and supplies are picked up.

Today, I am submitting a lists of election judges for the November general Election, based on the outcome of the last Governor's election, November 1994 Plus a list of alternates to serve in case there are cancellations, from the approved list But I am insisting that they receive more "Training".

If commissioner's court appoints judges from this list, I would like for them to put a "CONDITION OR STIPULATION" into those appointments I still believe that the Judges that did not attend the training seminar, need more training & should be expected to get certified election training before being allowed to work in the General Election, November 5, 1996. I have written to Ann McGeehan, Secretary of State Elections Division, and requested that a session be given here in Polk County, sometime during September or October. I haven't received a reply yet, but I plan to see her next Week at the Annual State Election Law School in Austin.

Last & in closing, I want Mr. Fogleman to know that I take my job duties & responsibilities very "SERIOUS". I always try to search out answers to problems, and "THINK" about decisions very carefully, that will affect the community and the many citizens that have entrusted me with this most important postiion.




