RECITALS

WHEREAS the Issuer and Prior Trustee entered into a Trust Indenture dated as of December 1 1986 the instruments listed on Exhibit A annexed hereto by and between the Issuer and the Prior Trustee (the 'Indenture'),

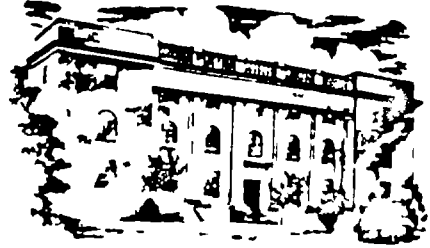
