

RESOLUTION

OF THE POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

Calling for State Reimbursement to Counties detaining "Blue Warrant" State Parole Violators

Whereas, The State of Texas issues arrest warrants ("blue warrants") for parole violators and the Elected Sheriff of Polk County and his Deputies are required by the State to arrest, transport, detain, house, feed and care for these State of Texas Parole Violators for periods as long as ninety (90) days, and


Whereas, The Citizens and Taxpayers of Polk County are thereby forced to fund the arrest, transport, detention, housing, feeding and care of these State of Texas parole violators, and

Whereas, The State's requirement for the County's arrest, transport, detention, housing, feeding and care of these State of Texas parole violators represents an unfunded mandate of the State which creates a severe financial burden on the Citizens of Polk County, and


Whereas, The State of Texas has deemed that Polk County is not eligible for State reimbursement of the costs incurred by the County in carrying out the State's mandate,


Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Commissioners Court of Polk County, Texas hereby requests that the Legislature of the State of Texas, meeting in its' 75th session in Austin, Texas, change the eligibility criteria to allow Polk County to be reimbursed at the rate of Thirty Five dollars (\$35 00) per day for the costs incurred in the arrest, transport, detention, housing, feeding and care of these "blue warrant" State of Texas parole violators, or to allow for the immediate placement of these State of Texas parole violators in a state facility


