**RESOLUTION****OF THE POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**


Opposing the Texas Parks & Wildlife designation of a Fish Sanctuary  
in an area 1,000 ft below the Lake Livingston Dam

- Whereas,** In a public hearing to be held on January 15, 1997 in the Polk County Courthouse, Texas Parks and Wildlife will consider the possible designation of the area between the floodgates and cable below the Lake Livingston dam as a fish sanctuary, and
- Whereas,** Texas Parks and Wildlife will also consider other restrictions in an effort to protect the striped bass and blue catfish brood stock which has historically been supplied from this area below the Lake Livingston Dam, and
- Whereas,** This Commissioners Court has received public input opposing the designation of a fish sanctuary in this area or any further restrictions upon fishing within the subject area - other than those already in force, and
- Whereas,** Said public comment has indicated that such a designation or additional restrictions would cause unnecessary hardship on those individuals fishing from said area and that brood stock control may be effectively achieved by the stricter enforcement of fishing restrictions already in place within the subject area, and
- Whereas,** This Commissioners Court, in consideration of the public comments received, is of the opinion that existing restrictions upon fishing in this area - if strictly enforced - are sufficient to protect the brood stock needed from this area,

**Now, Therefore, be it Resolved** that the Commissioners Court of Polk County, Texas opposes designation of the area between the floodgates and cable below the Lake Livingston dam as a fish sanctuary

**Be it Further Resolved,** that the Polk County Commissioners Court also opposes any imposing of additional fishing restrictions in this area by Texas Parks and Wildlife, but rather, calls for the stricter enforcement of existing restrictions to address the issue of brood stock protection

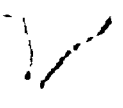

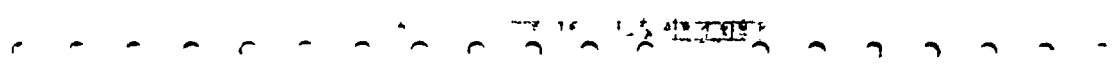

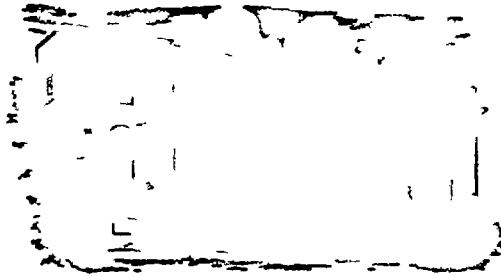
