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## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF POLK, STATE OF TEXAS, called "County", acting by and through its duly elected Commissioners' Court and the CITY OF ONALASKA, a City located within Polk County, Texas, herein after called "City", acting by and through its duly elected Mayor and City Council. Under the terms, authority and provisions of Article 6702-1 Section 2 010 and Article 4413 (32c) of the Revised Civil Statues of the States of Texas

# EXHIBIT A FINAL PAYMENT REIMBURSEMENT

Texas Eastern Transmission Corporation (TETCO) has estimated the cost associated with this Agreement to be \$16,416 00. This estimated cost shall not be considered a maximum, minimum, or guarantee for the work associated with this Agreement and Polk County agrees to reimburse the entire actual cost, both direct and indirect, incurred by TETCO Such cost shall include, but not be limited to, all permits, allowance for funds used during any associated construction, materials, labor, administrative overhead, services, licenses, fees, loss of gas, right-of-way grants, changes in scope or operation and any and all other costs, burdens and expenses of any type or nature. Polk County further agrees to pay all reasonable attorney's fees should this Agreement be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or should it be collected through any court.

Within one hundred eighty (180) days after completion of the work contemplated in this Agreement, TETCO shall use its best efforts to final invoice for any outstanding cost incurred by TETCO pursuant to this Agreement including all termination costs

Should Polk County fail to pay part or all of the amount of any invoice for service provided when such amount is due, TETCO may charge interest on the unpaid portion of the invoice computed from such due date until the date of payment at the rate of interest and in the manner prescribed for pipeline refunds as set forth in Section 154 67 (c) of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's Regulation under the Natural Gas Act.

For a period of one (1) year after completion of the work, Polk County shall have the right to audit TETCO's books and records directly relating to the work. Should such audit reveal any errors or inaccuracies, a proper correction of adjustment shall be made as promptly as practicable thereafter. Any such audit shall be conducted at TETCO's offices in Houston, Texas during TETCO's business hours. Polk County's right to audit does not reduce the responsibility of Polk County to pay any TETCO invoices in full within the thirty (30) day period required.

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
