



Honorable Judge Thompson

I am petitioning the Court of Polk County, Texas to abandon 177 feet of <u>dead end</u> road at the west end of Beamon Drive in Wiggins Village #2, Section 1 in Polk County, Texas This section of Beamon Drive is unused and grown over with tall trees and dense undergrowth.

I own the properties adjacent north (lots 1 thru 4) and adjacent south (lots 36 thru 44) of Beamon Drive The property adjacent west of the <u>dead end</u> of Beamon Drive has clear and currently used access via FM 2457 Therefore, the abandonment of the requested portion of Beamon Drive would not impede access to any properties, nor would any current easements for utilities be affected

If this petition should be granted, I would propose to purchase the abandoned portion of property from Polk County, Texas for the amount of \$500 00, along with payment of appropriate taxes



THIS AGREEMENT is made between Compliance Consortium Corporation a Texas Corporation, (Consortium) with its principal offices located at 910 South Highway Boulevard Belton, Texas 76513 and Polk County (Member) located at Polk County Courthouse Livingston, Texas 77351

## Section 1 Scope of Relationship

#### 1 1 Member

The member will provide to the consortium information required to comply with DOT regulations 49CFR, Part 382 as follows

- A. Data on existing and new regulated employees in a timely manner
  - 1 Social Security Number
  - 2 Full name
  - 3 Home address
  - 4 Home telephone number
  - 5 Date of employment
  - 6 Primary Job Position
- B The member will make available any regulated employee covered under this agreement, for the purpose of conducting pre-employment, unannounced random, post- accident, reasonable suspicion, return to duty and/or follow-up alcohol and/or drug screening without reasonable delay
- C The member shall provide sufficient notice to the consortium for scheduling of any required alcohol and/or drug screening
- D In the event a regulated employee's activity triggers the requirement of an alcohol and/or drug test, the member must notify the consortium immediately
- E The member grants the consortium the authority to act as the member's agent to gather confidential employee test information

#### 1 2 Consortium

The consortium shall provide to the member the following services based on the DOT regulations as follows

- A. All testing cost associated with random alcohol and drug testing
- B Certification training in reasonable suspicion for existing supervisors.
- C Assistance in developing an alcohol and drug testing policy, if requested.
- D Provide all regulated employee with an alcohol and drug testing information handbook
- E Set-up employee testing files
- F Administration of employee compliance records

The VENDOR understands that it must have sufficient financial solvency to sustain said agreement performance until adequate funds are received by the COUNCIL to reimburse said VENDOR

The COUNCIL shall not be liable to the VENDOR for costs incurred or performance rendered unless such costs and performances are strictly in accordance with the terms of this agreement, including but not limited to, terms governing the VENDOR promised performance and unit rates specified

The COUNCIL shall not be liable to the VENDOR for any expenditures which are not allowable costs as defined in the rules and regulations, Federal Register Vol 55 #63 and Code of Federal Regulations Title 45, Part 74, as of October 1, 1990, or which expenditures have not been made in accordance with the fiscal guidelines and requirements outlined by the Texas Department on Aging

The COUNCIL shall not be liable to the VENDOR for expenditures made in violation of regulations promulgated under the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, or in violation of any other regulations promulgated pursuant to the act or any of its amendments

The COUNCIL agrees to make payment to the VENDOR in the amounts and upon the terms, provisions and budgets as set forth in Direct Service Agreement, and the VENDOR agrees to accept such payments as full compensation for services performed hereunder. Invoices received by the 5th working day will be paid net 30 days

#### II ACCESSIBILITY OF RECORDS

The VENDOR shall give COUNCIL, TdoA, the Comptroller General of the United States, and the State of Texas, through any authorized representatives, the access to and right to examine all records, books, papers, contracts, or other documents related to this agreement. Such right of access shall continue as long as such records, or any of them, are in existence. VENDOR shall include the substance of this provision in all subcontracts.

#### III PAYMENT SUSPENSION AND VENDOR TERMINATION

In the event monitoring/evaluation activities by the COUNCIL or its VENDOR agents, disclose serious deficiencies in the operation of agreement, the COUNCIL may elect to suspend or terminate this agreement upon fifteen (15) days written notice from the COUNCIL to the VENDOR. The VENDOR, upon notification of such suspension or termination, shall have the right to appeal such suspension or termination following procedures outlined in 40 TAC 254 17, as applicable This agreement may be terminated upon the occurrence of any of the following events

- a Discontinuance of funding to the COUNCIL from the Texas Department on Aging, or
- b Failure of the VENDOR to comply with any or all of the terms and conditions of this agreement and any attachments thereto, or
- c Mutual agreement between the COUNCIL and the VENDOR, or
- d Discovered or disclosed deficiencies in the operation of the VENDOR supported under the provisions of this agreement

In the event of termination, final billings for units of services delivered pursuant to the agreement will be submitted to the COUNCIL within fifteen (15) calendar days from termination by the VENDOR but it is understood that no units delivered after the termination date will be reimbursed

RECEIVING AGENCY acknowledges that records may not be located in the searching process instituted by RECEIVING AGENCY or records which are located may have errors due to

- A) normal key-entry errors in spellings,
- B) accidental failure on the part of the PERFORMING AGENCY to update a file for an amendment or paternity determination, and
- C) the event year does not exist on the system.

RECEIVING AGENCY will notify PERFORMING AGENCY in writing, at least monthly of errors or suspected errors that exist on the data base information.

RECEIVING AGENCY is to maintain an inventory control and account for each document produced on "bank note" paper, including voided documents

RECEIVING AGENCY is responsible for maintaining a system of vital record keeping that is in accordance with Chapters 191 through 195 of the Health and Safety Code and the regulations adopted thereunder

# IL TERM

The term of this contract will begin upon its execution by both parties and will continue in force and effect until either party gives sixty (60) days written notice of termination to the other party

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### COMPENSATION

RECEIVING AGENCY agrees to reimburse PERFORMING AGENCY \$1 83 (One Dollar and 83/100) for each Certification of Vital Record printed as a result of searches of the database

A monthly stemized billing showing the number of transactions by date will be submitted to RECEIVING AGENCY by PERFORMING AGENCY and payment will be made no later than thirty (30) days following the billing date Payment will be considered made on the date postmarked

## IV. CONFIDENTIALITY

RECEIVING AGENCY will maintain sufficient safeguards to prevent release or disclosure of any information obtained hereunder to anyone other than RECEIVING AGENCY employee(s) or those who have an official need for the information and are authorized to receive such records. RECEIVING AGENCY further agrees records obtained and issued, as specified under this contract, will be used for purposes as herein set out and the use of these records or data for other purposes must be agreed to in writing by both parties

### V. SECURITY

Receiving Agency agrees to implement all reasonable and necessary procedures to ensure that only authorized users will have access and will notify TDH immediately should it detect a security violation by one of its employees or any other person

# VI. TERMINATION

This contract may be terminated either by maintal agreement of the parties or by either party upon the giving of sixty (60) days written notice to the other party. RECEIVING AGENCY agrees to pay PERFORMING AGENCY for all services completed prior to the effective date of such termination. Performing Agency may immediately suspend this agreement upon reasonable suspicion that terms of this agreement have been violated by the Receiving Agency or one of its employees. If, after investigation it is concluded that a violation of this agreement has occurred, Performing Agency may terminate this agreement without further notice.

# VII. APPLICABLE LAWS AND STANDARDS

RECEIVING AGENCY further certifies by execution of this contract that it is not ineligible for participation in federal or state assistance programs under Executive Order 12549, Debarment and Suspension RECEIVING AGENCY specifically asserts that it does not owe a single substantial debt or a number of outstanding debts to a federal or state agency A false statement regarding RECEIVING AGENCY'S status will be treated as a material breach of this contract and may be grounds for termination at the option of PERFORMING AGENCY

# VIII. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this contract will be construed to be illegal or invalid, this will not affect the legality or validity of any of the other provisions hereof. The illegal or invalid provision will be deemed stricken and deleted herefrom to the same extent and effect as if never incorporated herein, but all other provisions will continue

# IX. FUNDING

This contract is contingent upon the availability of funding RECEIVING AGENCY will have no right of action against the State of Texas or the PERFORMING AGENCY in the event that PERFORMING AGENCY is unable to fulfill its obligations under this contract as a result of the suspension, termination, withdrawal, or failure of funding to PERFORMING AGENCY or lack of sufficient funding of PERFORMING AGENCY for any Attachment(s) to this contract. If funds become unavailable, provisions of the Termination Article will apply

# X. HOLD HARMLESS

Except to the extent that Chapter 104 of the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code is applicable to this contract, RECEIVING AGENCY agrees to hold PERFORMING AGENCY and/or federal government harmless and to indemnify them from and against any and all claims, demands, and causes of action of every kind and character which may be asserted by any third party occurring in any way incident to, arising out of, or in connection with the performance of services by RECEIVING AGENCY under this contract to the extent allowed by law, excluding, however, occurrences arising under subparagraph IB of this contract.




