MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN DEEP EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AND

Honorable John Thompson, Polk County Judge

I. PERIOD OF AGREEMENT

The terms of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Deep East Council of Governments (DETCOG) and Honorable John Thompson is effective for the period of August 1, 1998 until July 31, 1999

Either DETCOG or the Honorable John Thompson may propose amendments to this MOU at any time by providing written notice. To become effective, amendments shall require approval of the DETCOG Executive Director, DETCOG Criminal Justice Director, and the Honorable John Thompson.

This MOU will assist DETCOG in effectively providing quality services to at-risk youths and their families. DETCOG's policies stipulate that "no youth will be denied services due to refusal of the family to participate in counseling. If the family is unavailable or refuses to participate, the youth will be seen and provided counseling services at school or STAR offices." The following counties are currently provided STAR services. Angelina, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, and Trinity

II. PURPOSE

- Jointly participate in the development and implementation of Services to At-Risk Youth program "DET/TRY-STAR" in the Deep East Texas region, including the most efficient use of the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services (TDPRS) STAR program funds TDPRS places its highest priority on keeping youths in their homes (Family Preservation) We will receive referrals from CPS workers, juvenile probation officers, and ISD'S who can refer families to STAR These agencies will also work with the STAR program to provide training on what type of clients we can work with.
- Encourage the development of mutual training activities for providers of services to youth personnel at the regional levels, with particular emphasis on prevention techniques, family crisis intervention, and enhancement of client self-determination. This can be achieved whenever there is an opportunity for cross training to assist each agency employee's understanding of the requirements for acceptance in their program.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING DET/TRY-STAR Program Page 2

- Coordinate case referral procedures for clients and their families to assure that the most appropriate and least restrictive service is accessible and that confidentiality is maintained.
- Ensure that staff at the local level coordinate services and work together to carry out the mutual objectives of the two agencies

III. CONTACT PERSONS

The DETCOG will remain in contact with juvenile and local officials in the counties STAR services are provided. There will be communication as needed or meetings called to provide updates on the DET/TRY-STAR program.

IV. CERTIFICATION

The signatures below acknowledge the existence of this MOU between DETCOG and Honorable John Thompson. The collective efforts of each person involved will be a great asset to STAR youths and their families.

PROHIBITION OF OUTDOOR BURNING EMERGENCY ORDER # 98-01

WHEREAS, in accordance with provisions of the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, a state of disaster has been declared based on the imminent threat of disaster from wildfire, and WHEREAS, declaration of such disaster authorized the imposition of controls on activities which tend to increase the likelihood of such fires,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED that the following emergency regulations are hereby established for all unincorporated areas of Polk County, Texas for the duration of the above mentioned declaration

(1) Actions Prohibited

A person violates this order if he/she burns any combustible material outside of an enclosure, which serves to contain all flames and/or sparks, or orders such burning by others

(2) Enforcement

- (a) Upon notification of suspected outdoor burning, the fire department assigned to the location of the fire shall respond to the scene and take immediate measures to contain and/or extinguish the fire
- (b) As soon as possible, a duly commissioned peace officer shall be sent to the scene to investigate the nature of the fire
- (c) If in the opinion of the officer at the scene and/or the Fire Chief, the goal of the order can be attained by informing the responsible party about the prohibitions established by this order, the officer may, at his/her discretion, notify the party about the provisions of this order and request compliance with it. In such instances, an entry of this notification shall be made into the dispatcher's log containing the time, date, and place of the warning, and the name of the person receiving the warning
- (3) At the discretion of a peace officer and/or Fire Chief, second or flagrant violations of this order may be prosecuted in accordance with the statutes and procedures governing misdemeanors.

BE IT ALSO ORDERED that this order may be enforced by any duly commissioned peace officer and that the venue for prosecution of this order will be the County Court-at-Law, Livingston, Texas



DECLARATION OF DISASTER THREAT OF WILDFIRES

WHEREAS, Polk County has not had rainfall for an extended period, and WHEREAS, weather forecasters offer little promise of a change in the hot, dry conditions in the near future, and

WHEREAS, these hot, dry conditions pose the threat of large, dangerous and fastmoving wildfires, and

WHEREAS such fires have the potential of endangering lives and damaging property on a large scale, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Disaster Act of 1975 authorizes declaration of a state of disaster "if the threat of disaster is imminent", and

WHEREAS, the magnitude of the potential damage and the rapidity at which such a fire could escalate to major proportions constitute an imminent threat of disaster; and

WHEREAS, declaration of such disaster authorizes the imposition of controls on activities which tend to increase the likelihood of fires, and

WHEREAS, such controls, once implemented, have the potential of protecting lives and property by mitigating the threat of dangerous fires,

BE IT THEREFORE PROCLAIMED that I, John P Thompson, County Judge of Polk County, do hereby declare a state of disaster based on the threat of large wildfires in Polk County, Texas, and

BE IT ALSO PROCLAIMED that this state of disaster will continue until rescinded in accordance with the above statute and order, but in no instance will this declaration continue for more than seven days without authorization by the Polk County Commissioners Court,

BE IT ALSO PROCLAIMED this state of disaster is being declared solely for the purpose of implementing controls aimed at mitigating the hazard posed by wildfires during the current hot, dry weather

BE IT ALSO ORDERED THAT the purpose of this order is the mitigation of the hazard posed by wildfires by curtailing the practice of outdoor burning which purpose is to be taken into account in any enforcement action based upon this order


