INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
POLK COUNTY, TEXAS  
AND  
CITY OF LIVINGSTON, TEXAS

THE STATE OF TEXAS #  
COUNTY OF POLK #

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the COUNTY OF POLK, STATE OF TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as "County", acting by and through its duly elected Commissioners' Court, and the CITY OF LIVINGSTON, TEXAS, a City located within Polk County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "City", acting by and through its duly elected Mayor and City Council, under the terms, authority, and provisions of Secs 791 001, et seq , Gov. Code of the St. of Tex.

WHEREAS, it has been found and determined by the Commissioners' Court of Polk County, Texas, and by the City Council of the City of Livingston, Texas, that it is advantageous to each named governmental entities that services be exchanged between the County and the City with regard to the governmental functions hereinafter described, and that the exchange of such services will result in increased efficiency and economy to the citizens of each

such governmental entity with regard to the described governmental functions, and

WHEREAS, it is agreed by the governing bodies of the County and the City that the consideration in support of this agreement is the exchange of services as herein contemplated

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and undertakings hereinafter described, it is agreed

- 1 This agreement shall continue on a year to year basis and may be amended in writing, subject to prior agreement of both parties, and may be terminated by either party on thirty [30] days' written notice
- 2 The authority of each political subdivision to perform a service under this agreement includes the authority to apply the rules, regulations, and ordinances of the political subdivision providing the service or services contemplated by this agreement
- 3 The County agrees to provide personnel and equipment at its own expense to assist in the construction, improvement, maintenance, and/or repair of certain

streets, parks, and/or public facilities located within the corporate limits of the City of Livingston

4 Periodically, during the term of this agreement, the County and City shall agree to the location and type of assistance to be provided pursuant to this agreement, and it is expressly understood between the parties that the County shall have no obligation to provide any service or work until personnel and equipment are available to provide agreed services or work

5 It is understood that in providing any such services, all employees of the County shall remain County employees of Polk County and shall not be considered agents, employees or borrowed servants of the City

6 For and in consideration of the above agreement by the County, the City agrees to provide all materials, and shall be responsible for all engineering, surveying, and supervision of the construction of the services or work contemplated by this agreement City also agrees to provide all warning and safety signs and other


safety protection as required when the County is performing such work

- 7 It is understood that each party will waive all claims for compensation for any loss, damage, personal injury, or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this agreement
- 8 The provisions of this agreement shall be cumulative of all provisions of the statutes of the State of Texas, and all provisions of the Charter and Ordinances of the City, and does not waive, modify or affect to any extent whatsoever the availability of the defense of governmental immunity to tort liability available to each of them under the laws of the State of Texas, and insofar as City is concerned, the Charter of the City of Livingston
- 9 In connection with the subject matter of this agreement, the governmental units furnishing services shall have exclusive policy-making authority pertinent to the services furnished, that is, the City shall



have no control over the County personnel or operation  
of equipment

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THE STATE OF TEXAS #

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

COUNTY OF POLK #

WHEREAS, on or about the 15<sup>th</sup> day of ~~November~~ <sup>December</sup>, 1998, an agreement was entered into by and between the COUNTY OF POLK, STATE OF TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as "County", acting by and through its duly elected Commissioners' Court, and the CITY OF LIVINGSTON, TEXAS, a City located within Polk County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "City", acting by and through its duly elected Mayor and City Council, and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to supplement said agreement, and it is agreed by the governing bodies of the County and the City that the consideration in support of this addendum is the exchange of services as herein contemplated

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and undertakings hereinafter described, it is agreed

- 1 The County agrees to permit and inspect all on-site septic facilities within the City, including, but not limited to, soil evaluations, and evaluating septic systems

- 2 The City agrees to comply with all present or future laws pertaining to the inspection and approval of on-site septic facilities within the State of Texas, including minimum state standards
- 3 The County shall enforce reasonable rules and regulations in the conduct of its business, provided that such regulations, including rights and charges, shall be subject to the approval of the City, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas
- 4 The City agrees to notify the County of the installation of on-site septic systems, and of all on-site septic systems which need inspecting
- 5 The County will charge the sum of One Hundred Sixty and No/100 [\$160 00] Dollars for each permit issued for septic systems within the City, and shall be solely responsible for collecting such charges from the customers The fee herein provided is subject to change, but will be the same amount that the County charges for outside the City limits
- 6 Both parties to this addendum clearly understand and agree that it is the intent of all parties for the on-site septic facilities of the City to operate fully

and completely in compliance with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations concerning waste disposal, and both parties will use their best efforts to ensure continued compliance with all laws and regulations




