

## ORDER OF THE POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

WHEREAS, on June 20, 1994, the Polk County Commissioners Court duly adopted an Order approving the Lease of the Polk County Hospital and finding that it is in the best interest of the County to close the current Hospital as a health care facility when the new Hospital is built; and

WHEREAS, the New Hospital has been constructed and is presently providing health care services to the citizens of Polk County; and

WHEREAS, it remains in the best interest of the County to close the current Hospital and further utilize this property for the benefit of the citizens of Polk County in another capacity; now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Polk County, Texas:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 263.030, Health and Safety Code, the Polk County Hospital is hereby closed as a medical facility.

Section 2. This Order shall be final 30 days after its adoption unless at least ten percent (10%) of the qualified voters in the County petition the Commissioners Court requesting an election to determine whether the hospital should be closed.





Kennedy, County Clerk when and where among other proceedings had, the following orders and decrees were duly had considered and passesd.

Motioned by E.Y. Brooks, seconded by L.W.Parrish to confirm appointments of All Hospital Board members, (1) Gordon Reily (2) Jasper Cockrell (3) Pete Weems (4) George Schoeneman (5) R.A. Smith (6)C.T. Jones (7) Wayne Baker (8) Lewis Gerlach (9) A.A. Wells. E.Y. Brooks, L.W. Parrish, John Pruett voting yes and Carter Watts voting mo.

Motioned by E.Y. Brooks, seconded by L.W. Parrish to accept recommendation of Hospital Board to Consolidate Corrigan Unit with the Livingston Unit and close the Corrigan Unit effective December 31st, 1967. E.Y. Brooks, L.W. Parrish voting yes; Carter Watts, John Pruett voting no. Judge Walters breaking the tie vote by voting yes.

Motioned by Carter Watts, seconded by John Pruett to direct auditor to Inventory all



equipment in Corrigan Unit. E.Y. Brooks, L.W. Parrish, Carter Watts, John Pruett voting yes be and the same is hereby approved.

Motioned by Carter Watts, seconded by John Pruett that nothing in Corrigan Unit be moved from building. Carter Watts, John Pruitt and L.W. Parrish voting yes. E.Y. Brooks voting no.

There appearing no further business Court Adjourned this the 15th day of December 1967.
