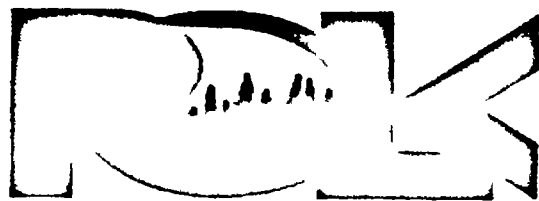


**WHEREAS,** the County of Polk has erected county road signs throughout the County, and

This Contract shall commence on September 1, 1999 and shall terminate on August 31, 2002, unless terminated earlier by provisions of this Contract


