



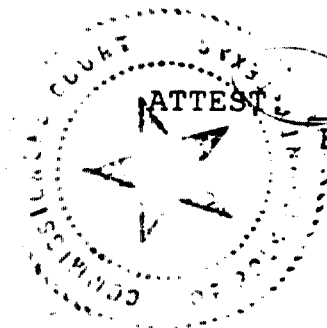

# POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

## NOTICE TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS

The Polk County Commissioners Court has recently completed a voluntary redistricting including:

- Changes to the Commissioners' Precinct lines
- Changes to the Justice of the Peace and Constable Precinct lines
- The realignment of election precincts which may have affected your voting box

Before these changes can be put into effect, they must be reviewed by the United States Attorney General. To assist the Attorney General in this review, the County has submitted, pursuant to the requirements of Section Five of the Voting Rights Act, complete documentation concerning the proposed changes as well as information concerning the process through which these changes came about. The Attorney General's review process usually takes sixty (60) days and is currently underway.

During this sixty-day period, a complete copy of the documentation supplied to the Attorney General is available for public review. Please contact the County Judge's Office for information concerning your right to inspect these documents.

## AVISO A TODAS LAS PERSONAS INTERESADAS

La Corte de los Comisionados del Condado ha completado recientemente una nueva division en distritos voluntaria que incluye:

- Cambios a las fronteras de distrito de los Comisionados
- Cambios a las fronteras de distrito del Juez de las Paz y el Jefe de Policia
- La alineación nueva de los precintos de elección que podía haber afectado su sitio de votación.

Antes de que esto cambio puedan entrar en vigencia, deben de ser revisados por el Procurador General de los Estados Unidos. A fin de ayudar al Procurador General en esta revisión el Condado ha presentado, de acuerdo con los requisitos de la Sección 5 del Acto de Derechos de Votación, la documentación completa tocante a los cambios propuestos tanto como la información respecto al proceso por el cual resultaron estos cambios. Este proceso suele llevar sesenta días y esta ya en curso.

Durante este período de sesenta días, una copia completa de la documentación presentada al Procurador General está disponible para la inspección publica. Favor de comunicarse con la oficina del Juez del Condado para información tocante a su derecho de inspeccionar estos documentos.
