DATE: March 31, 2003

Following our discussion of a new approach to the Judicial Center and its occupants, we met with the respective court and department representatives March 21<sup>st</sup>. Our earlier notes showed that approximately one-third of the expanded County Clerk's space would be devoted to the Courts Department, and we have used that as the basis for such space with the Judicial Center. We arrive at a building totaling 56,300 gross square feet, as shown on the attached Summary of Space Requirements.

With respect to the project budget, we have revisited the earlier construction estimate by Kingham Construction Co., updating it for two years of escalation and validating it with a similar building that Kingham is building in another county. The indirect costs have been updated by information on file here, and validated by recent experience. We arrive at a total project budget of \$9,795,070, as shown on the attached Project Budget.

If you would like for me to provide more back-up information, I'll be happy to. But, as we know more information can sometimes prove troublesome.

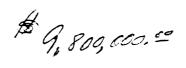
