WHEREAS, The Chief Appraiser has notified this Court of Polk County's voting entitlement for the election of Members of the Board of Directors of the Polk Central Appraisal District for the 2003-2004 term and has provided the names of the nominees for said positions; and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court met in a regularly called meeting on Wednesday, November 12, 2003 with all Members present and, among other items of business, James J. "Buddy" Purvis made the motion, with Bobby Smith seconding, to cast the Polk County voting entitlement of 1, 398 votes as follows; 834 votes for Clarke Evans (nominated by Polk County) and 564 votes for Janie Cockrell (nominated by Corrigan-Camden I.S.D.). ORDER

OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF POLK COUNTY, TEXAS

LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF COUNTY AD VALOREM TAXES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED ON THE RESIDENCE HOMESTEADS OF THE DISABLED AND OF THE ELDERLY AND THEIR SURVIVING SPOUSES

WHEREAS, H.J.R. No. 16 and H.B. No. 136 of the 78th Legislature of the State of Texas, Regular Session, enacted by the passage of Proposition 13 in the election held September 13, 2003, amends Section 1-b, Article VIII of the Texas Constitution and Subchapter B, Chapter 11 of the Tax Code, authorizing a county to establish an ad valorem tax freeze on residence homesteads of the disabled and of the elderly and their spouses and limiting the amount of county ad valorem taxes that may be imposed on said residence homesteads; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court, by majority vote, is authorized to enact this local option; and

WHEREAS, the Polk County Commissioners Court finds that it is in the best interest of the County and its citizens to enact this option and, in a regularly called session on November 12, 2003, voted unanimously in favor of said option.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered that, effective January 1, 2004, Polk County shall establish the county ad valorem tax freeze on residence homesteads of the disabled and of the elderly and their spouses.
