Dear Judge Thompson;

The Commissioners Court of Polk County appointed a steering committee to review proposals submitted by interested vendors for the collection of delinquent fines and fees owed to Polk County. That committee was made up of the four J.P.'s of Polk County, the Polk County Auditor, the Polk County District Clerk and the Polk County Clerk. We recently met and reviewed the proposals set before us.

We the committee recommend that Polk County enter into a contract with Municipal Services Bureau effective immediately to collect delinquent fines and fees for all J.P. Courts. County Court and District Court. This was the unanimous decision by the committee and we respectfully submit our recommendation to you.

For the Courts information, Net Data will charge Polk County \$2500.00 for software to accommodate this service. We suggest that the \$2500.00 needed be paid from the J.P. Technology fund.

We have notified all the vendors who submitted proposals that the Commissioners Court will receive the committee's recommendation on Tuesday November 25, 2003 and the vendor who is selected by Commissioners Court will be notified as the Court makes it's decision.

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AGREEMENT

FILE COPY

This Agreement is made and entered into this <u>25th</u> day of <u>November</u>, 2003, by and between Gila Corporation, d/b/a Municipal Services Bureau, a Texas Corporation [hercinafter, "MSB"], and Polk County, Texas [hereinafter, the "County"], who agree as follows:

I. ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. <u>Defendant Contact.</u> MSB will mail notices, telephone or otherwise contact Defendants with outstanding cases with the County in order to attempt to notify Defendants of their obligation with the County. The purpose of the contact is to offer Defendants the opportunity to resolve their obligation voluntarily, before further action is contemplated by the County. The County will provide the name and last known address of the Defendants, all information regarding the date(s) of the alleged violation(s), the date judgment was entered against the Defendants in the court having jurisdiction over the matter or the date the citation was filed, and the amount of any such fine(s). When appropriate, MSB will attempt to locate Defendants when the last known address is invalid.
- B. <u>Correct Information</u>. MSB will rely completely on the County to provide correct information about the Defendants' existing cases and, specifically, about any dollar amount in question, and the County will immediately update and correct any information it has provided to MSB. In particular, the County will immediately notify MSB of any payment or other satisfaction of judgment made directly to the County or any other action affecting the amount or timing of monies owed by the Defendants to the County.
- C. Accounts Returned. The County will allow MSB a minimum of 180 days to contact a Defendant about their case. This time period will begin with the first day of the following month in which the account was referred to MSB. Upon request by the County, MSB will cease contacting a Defendant whose case remains outstanding at that time.
- D. <u>Defendants</u> Referred to the County. MSB will refer Defendants who wish to resolve their obligation with the County other than by payment to the person designated by the County to respond to the Defendants' request.

II. COMMISSIONS ON FINES COLLECTED.

A. <u>Basic Commission Rate.</u> As provided by Texas statutes, 30.00 percent may be added by the County to the total amount due on certain cases more than 60 days past due and referred to MSB for collection. The County may also instruct MSB to add the fee upon MSB's receipt of case information. It is at the County's sole discretion as to what cases are applicable to the 30.00 percent add-on. For all cases referred by the County to MSB for which the County is paid (in whole or in part), regardless of whether payment is accepted directly by the County or by MSB on the County's behalf and regardless of whether 30.00 percent is added to the original balance or not, the County will pay to MSB, in Travis County, Texas, a 23.077 percent commission rate on the amount collected. Example: \$100 original balance x 130% - \$130, \$130 collected x 23.077% fee = \$30 fee.

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B. Notification of Collections. MSB will notify the County daily of any monics it receives from Defendants towards payments of fines. The County, through the Municipal Court, may then accept or reject the payment offered by the Defendant. By the fifteenth of each month, MSB will provide detailed reporting to the County to identify all cases known to be resolved during the prior month and to remit monies collected on the County's behalf. MSB makes no warranties or representations, expressed or implied, about the amount of funds that will be collected and MSB shall have no liability for any amounts uncollected. The only liability of MSB will be to forward any funds collected to the County, subject to MSB retaining its commission amount. The County authorizes MSB to endorse negotiable instruments made payable to the County and provided to MSB in payment of fines collected and to deduct commissions due on those fines paid directly to MSB from amounts collected by MSB. If MSB is required to invoice the County for commissions due, the County agrees to review the invoice and forward payment to MSB within 30 days of receipt of the invoice.

III. TERM OF AGREEMENT.

This Agreement will remain in full force and effect until terminated by either party in writing to the other at the addresses set out in this section. If the Agreement is terminated, any case information then held by MSB will be returned to the Court 90 days after the date of termination.

IV. OTHER PROVISIONS.

A. Indemnification. To the extent permitted by applicable law, MSB will indemnify and hold harmless the County from and against any and all loss, damages, liability, claims or injury resulting from all actions performed by MSB or its agents on MSB's behalf in connection with this Agreement; provided, however, that this Agreement shall not apply with respect to any erroneous information furnished to MSB by the County nor shall it apply to any act or omission of the County.

B. <u>Applicable Law.</u> This Agreement will be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and performable in Polk County, Texas.

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RESOLUTION EXPRESSING INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES TO BE INCURRED BY POLK COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Polk County, Texas (the "Issuer") is a Texas County and a political subdivision of the State of Texas authorized to issue obligations to finance its activities pursuant to various Texas statutes, including anticipation notes pursuant to Chapter 1431, Texas Government Code, the interest on which is excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes ("tax-exempt obligations") pursuant to Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code");

WHEREAS, the Issuer will make, or has made not more than 60 days prior to the date hereof, payments with respect to the acquisition, construction, repair and equipping of the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Issuer has concluded that it does not currently desire to issue tax-exempt obligations to finance the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Issuer desires to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the Issuer reasonably expects to issue tax-exempt obligations to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The Issuer reasonably expects to reimburse itself for all costs that have been or will be paid subsequent to the date that is 60 days prior to the date hereof and that are to be paid in connection with the acquisition, construction, repair and equipping of the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof.

Section 2. This resolution is also made to evidence the intent of the Issuer to make such reimbursements under Treas. Reg. § 1.150-2 and Section 1201.042, Texas Government Code.

Section 3. The Issuer reasonably expects that the maximum principal amount of tax-exempt obligations issued to reimburse the Issuer for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto will not exceed \$63,409.00.
