LEASE RENEWAL AMENDMENT

Lease: 8230 – Corrigan Term: 06/01/2005 through 05/31/2006

This Agreement is made and entered into on this ______ by and between the Lessor, County of Polk, and LESSEE, STATE OF TEXAS acting by and through the Texas Building and Procurement Commission.

With reference to Lease Contract 8230 – Corrigan, the occupying agency, the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC – 529), formerly the Department of Human Services (DHS- 324), continues to occupy and remains in possession of the leased premises for a period of 12 months, from June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006. This renewal period pertains to 3,040 square feet of space at \$0.00 annual rate, for a total of \$0.00 per month.

EASEMENT AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF POLK §

This Easement Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and executed this 25th day of January, 2005, by Polk County, Texas its successors and assigns, having its principal office at 101 West Church Street, Suite 300, Livingston, Texas ("Grantor") and T & R Assets, Inc. its successors and assigns, having its principal office at 7616 LBJ Freeway, Dallas, Texas ("Grantee").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, GRANTOR is the owner of that certain tract of land located in Throckmorton County, Texas as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes (hereinafter referred to as the "Property").

WHEREAS, Trust Pipeline Company, predecessor of GRANTEE, was granted an easement through, across and under the Property (the "Previous Easement") pursuant to the Judgment rendered by the Court of Throckmorton County, Texas on June 6, 1958 (Civil Docket 673).

WHEREAS GRANTOR and GRANTEE wish to terminate the Previous Easement and in lieu thereof provide for an easement for a six inch (6") pipeline on, through, across and under the Property;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) paid in hand by GRANTEE and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which GRANTOR hereby acknowledges:

- 1. The Previous Easement rights and privileges thereunder are hereby terminated.
- 2. GRANTOR does hereby grant and convey unto GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, a non-exclusive forty two feet (42') wide easement and right of way (the "Easement") for the purposes of laying, constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing, replacing, removing and abandoning one (1) six-inch (6") underground pipeline (with fittings, tie-overs, valves, cathodic protection equipment, communication equipment, and all appliances appurtenant thereto) (collectively, the "Pipeline") for the transportation of oil, gas, petroleum products, or related liquids, gases or substances on, through, across and under the Property which such Easement and right-of-way is depicted on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and described by a centerline legal description, Exhibit "C" (the "Easement Area").
- 3. The easement, rights and privileges herein granted shall be perpetual or for so long as GRANTEE shall need and/or utilize the easement for the purposes intended. The easement, rights and privileges granted herein shall terminate when, or at such time, as the purposes hereof cease to exist or are abandoned by GRANTEE.

- 4. GRANTEE shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the Easement Area over GRANTOR's Property so long as GRANTEE does not unreasonably interfere with the use of GRANTOR's Property.
- 5. GRANTOR does hereby bind itself, its legal representatives, successors and/or assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Easement and rights unto the said GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by through or under GRANTOR, but not otherwise.
- 6. It is expressly understood and agreed by and between the parties that the easement rights hereby granted shall be subject to and governed by the following provisions:
 - a. The easement, rights and privileges granted herein are non-exclusive and the GRANTOR reserves and retains the right to use the Easement Area for all purposes which are not inconsistent and do not interfere with the rights hereby granted.
 - b. This Agreement, and the rights, privileges, covenants, agreements and easements hereunder, shall be superior and senior to any lien placed upon the Property, including the lien of any mortgage or deed of trust.
 - c. The Easement is granted by GRANTOR to GRANTEE subject to all laws and governmental rules, regulations and statutes which may have any applicability to the uses granted herein.
 - d. There will be no aboveground installation with regard to the Pipeline, except for the following which may be established, located, constructed, operated and maintained:
 - (i) cathodic protection devices and markers, which GRANTEE shall use reasonable business efforts to locate at fence lines or property lines. Clearance between the Pipeline and other piping shall in general be a minimum of three feet (3'-0").
 - (ii) a gate valve and valve box in, on, upon and across the Property as further described in Exhibit "C".
 - e. The Easement is limited to laying, constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing, replacing, removing and abandoning the one Pipeline as described herein and Grantee agrees that without prior written consent of Grantor, GRANTEE, its successors and assigns shall not lay or agree to be laid any additional pipeline in the Easement Area.
- 7. GRANTEE shall maintain the Pipeline in accordance with all applicable laws consistent with that of other pipelines that it owns or operates. GRANTEE shall, at GRANTEE's sole cost and expense, keep the Easement Area reasonably free from the accumulation of waste, materials and rubbish caused by GRANTEE's activities hereunder. GRANTEE shall pay any and all

damages to buildings, roads, structures or other improvements of GRANTOR caused by the construction, maintenance, operation, alteration, repair, replacement or removal of the Pipeline.

- 8. GRANTOR shall use reasonable precautions to prevent damages to GRANTEE'S work and the Pipeline by GRANTOR, or any parties on behalf of GRANTOR.
- 9. GRANTEE shall maintain a general liability insurance policy covering all risk of loss relating to the Pipeline and shall correct any damage or injury to its work and property and to GRANTOR's land which may result solely from any of GRANTEE's activities hereunder.
- 10. GRANTEE, its successors and assigns, shall indemnify and save harmless GRANTOR, its successors and assigns, from any and all claims, losses and expenses whatsoever for injuries or other damages suffered or sustained by any person, firm or corporation to the extent arising from Grantee's negligent acts or willful misconduct in the construction, use, operation or repair of the Pipeline, including the breaking of such pipeline or the leaking of any substance therefrom, and also including any expense of compliance with environmental remediation when ordered by any regulatory agency having jurisdiction over such matters. IN NO EVENT SHALL EITHER PARTY HERETO BE LIABLE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT, IN CONTRACT OR TORT, FOR INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INDIRECT OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY TYPE, OR LOSS OF USE OR LOSS OF PROFITS, WHETHER OR NOT DUE TO THE NEGLIGENCE OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF A PARTY HERETO (INCLUDING THE PARTY AGAINST WHOM THE CLAIM IS MADE) OR THE PARTIES.
- 11. The failure of either party hereto to insist in any one or more instances upon performance of any of the terms, covenants or conditions of this Agreement by the other party shall not be construed as a waiver or a relinquishment of the future performance of any such terms, covenants or conditions by the other party and the obligation of the other party with respect to such future performance shall continue in full force and effect.
- 12. Invalidation of any of the provisions contained in this Agreement, or of the application thereof to any person by judgment or court order shall in no way effect any of the other provisions hereof or the application thereof to any other person and the same shall remain in full force and effect, unless enforcement of this Agreement as so invalidated would be unreasonable or grossly inequitable under all the circumstances or would frustrate the purposes of this Agreement.
- 13. This Agreement and the Exhibits hereto contain all the representations and the entire agreement between the parties to this Agreement with respect to the subject matter hereof. Any prior correspondence, memoranda or agreements are superseded in total by this Agreement and the Exhibits hereto. The provisions of this Agreement shall be construed as a whole according to their common meaning and not strictly for or against any party.



Survey Drawing of Easement Area





From a point on the West line of Block No. 7, said point being 2096' South from the NW/c thereof; thence in a Northeasterly direction a distance of approximately 2897' to a point on the North line of said Block 7, said point being 1950' East from the NW/c thereof; and from a point on the South line of the NE/4 of Block No. 6, said point being 939' West from the SE/c of said NE/4 of Block No. 6 and continuing in a Northeasterly direction to the fence line of a county road in the East line of said NE/4 of Block No. 6 and West line of Block No. 11, a distance of approximately 1562', and continuing in the same course to the fence line of a county road in the North line of Block No. 11 and South line of Block No. 13 a distance of approximately 1585', and continuing in the same course and crossing the East line of Block No. 13 and West line of Block No. 12, and continuing in the same course to a point on the fence line along the North line of block No. 12 a distance of approximately 3199', said point being 228' East from the NW/c of the said Block No. 12; and crossing the lands of Polk County a total distance of 9243' or 560.2 rods.

Therefore, in the event it should ever be determined that the calls for course and/or distance in the aforementioned centerline description do not actually locate said existing pipeline in the middle of the said (42) feet wide Easement, then the Easement shall be adjusted as to location in order that the intention of the parties will be achieved.

Aboveground Installation with regard to the Pipeline

A gate valve and valve box in, on, upon and across the tract of land out of Block No. 11 beginning at a point in the East R/W line of a country road, said point being 1309' South and 46' East from the NW/c of Block No. 11, and running thence South along the said East R/W line of said county road, a distance of 20'; thence N 35 deg. 48' E a distance of 20'; thence North a distance of 20'; thence S 35 deg. 48' W a distance of 20' to the place of beginning.

It is the intention of Grantor and Grantee that the existing gate valve and valve box would be located as described above. Therefore, in the event it should ever be determined that the calls for course and/or distance in the aforementioned description of aboveground installation do not actually locate said existing aboveground installation, then the Easement shall be adjusted as to location in order that the intention of the parties will be achieved.

WHEREAS, the Issuer will make, or has made not more than 60 days prior to the date hereof, payments with respect to the acquisition, construction, repair and equipping of the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Issuer has concluded that it does not currently desire to issue tax-exempt obligations to finance the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Issuer desires to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the Issuer reasonably expects to issue tax-exempt obligations to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The Issuer reasonably expects to reimburse itself for all costs that have been or will be paid subsequent to the date that is 60 days prior to the date hereof and that are to be paid in connection with the acquisition, construction, repair and equipping of the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto from the proceeds of tax-exempt obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof.

Section 2. This resolution is also made to evidence the intent of the Issuer to make such reimbursements under Treas. Reg. § 1.150-2 and Section 1201.042, Texas Government Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Issuer reasonably expects that the maximum principal amount of tax-exempt obligations issued to reimburse the Issuer for the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto will not exceed \$31,130.00.
