POLK COUNTY INDIGENT HEALTHCARE PROGRAM MANDATED MEDICAL PROVIDER APPOINTEES



As an amendment to its Mandated Provider Policies, Polk County Commissioners Court elects to appoint Specialized Care Physicians as "Mandated Providers" in accordance with Subtitle C. Indigent Health Care, Chapter 61, Indigent Health Care and Treatment Act, Subchapter A, section 61.030 and remain Title XIX Medicaid-Medicare enrolled provider. A "Mandated Provider" shall provide available medically necessary services under the direction of a Licensed Physician, to eligible county residents upon obtaining County pre-authorization prior to services. Polk County's appointed "Mandated Provider" for Gynecological services is Dr. F. Edward Waechter, M.D.

Physician Assistant

These services must be medically necessary provided by a P.A. under the direction of Dr. F. Edward Waechter, M. D. and billed by and paid to the supervising physician, in accordance with the Texas Indigent Health Care Act.

I Medically Necessary Services

- a. Mandated Providers shall provide medically necessary services within the scope of their license according to the Indigent Health Care Act and services preauthorized by Polk County Social Service Department, except where emergencies exist.
- b. Mandated Provider must contact Polk County Indigent Health Care Department prior to outpatient and hospital admissions or other referrals, except where emergencies may exist.

II. Prescription Medications

- a. If medically necessary and appropriate, Medical Provider will provide written prescriptions to Indigent Health Care patients. Medications are subject to limitations (up to three per month-cumulative).
- b. Non-covered medications will be the responsibility of patient.

III. Patient Requirement

Polk County Indigent Health Care eligible residents will be required to obtain medically necessary services from Mandated Providers, except 1) in an emergency; 2) when medically inappropriate; or 3) when care is not available.

IV. Compensation

a. Polk County Commissioners Court shall reimburse Mandated Providers for medically necessary services according to the Indigent Health Care Act known as Medicaid Reimbursements.

- Mandated Provider charges must be billed to County using appropriate HCFA b. 1500 forms to include correct CPT and service codes under the signature of a Licensed Physician.
- Compensation will be rendered within a period of 45 days or less from date c. invoices are received from Physician.
- d. Provider must bill County 95 days from the date services are rendered.

IV. Relationship and Indemnification of Parties

- The relationship of the parties under this Agreement is solely that of independent a. contractors. Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute, be construed to, or create a partnership, joint venture, or employment relationship between the parties hereto or any of their contractors.
- County and Provider, to the extent authorized under the Texas Constitution and b. Texas laws, without limitation, Chapter 102, Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, agree to hold each party, its officers, employees, and agents harmless from and indemnify each of them against any and all claims, actions, damages, suits, proceedings, judgments, and liabilities for personal injury, death, or property damage resulting from the acts or omissions of County or Provider or others under County's and Provider's supervision or control, and the acts of God, material or labor restriction by any governmental authority, civil riot, floods, hurricanes, or other natural disasters, and any other cause not reasonably within the control of County or Provider and which by the exercise of due diligence of County and/or Provider is unable, wholly or in part, to prevent or overcome.
- Supervising Physician and staff shall uphold requirements of the Federal Health c. Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and the Privacy Rule published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services at 45 CFR 160-164 (Privacy Rule). HIPAA and the Rule regulate the services of protected health information.

V. **Term and Termination**

The Polk County Commissioners Court appointment will remain in full force and effective for a period of twelve months and automatically renew subsequently in twelve months term. In the event either party, with or without cause, at any time, shall give to the other party at least 30 (thirty) days advance written notice, this appointment shall terminate on the future date specified in such notice.

Any notice, demand or communication required, permitted or desired to be given hereunder shall be deemed effectively given when personally delivered or mailed by prepaid certified mail addressed to either party and copied to the Director of Polk County Indigent Health Care.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that Polk County Commissioners Court, upon acceptance by the Medical Provider, does hereby appoint the named Medical Provider as a Polk County Indigent Health Care Mandated Provider, as described by the Indigent Health Care Act. This appointment will remain in effect until further action set forth by Polk County Commissioners Court.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made by and entered into between Angelina County, Texas (hereinafter "Contractor") and Polk County, Texas (hereinafter "County") on the date indicated below.

WHEREAS, County is seeking to provide for the housing and care of certain inmates incarcerated or to be incarcerated in its jail, and

WHEREAS, Contractor currently has the jail capacity and the ability to provide housing and care for such inmates, and

WHEREAS, both parties are political subdivisions of the State of Texas authorized to enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for such detention services pursuant to Chapter 791 of the <u>Government Code</u> (Vernon's 1992) (formerly Article 4413(32c), Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat.), and

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor desire to enter into an agreement pursuant to which the Contractor will provide housing and care for certain inmates incarcerated or to be incarcerated in the Lufkin Detention Center, 113 N. 2nd, Lufkin, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

DETENTION SERVICES

- 1.01 HOUSING AND CARE OF INMATES: Contractor agrees to accept, and provide for the secure custody, care and safekeeping of inmates of the County in accordance with state and local law, including the minimum standards promulgated by the Texas Commission on Jail Standards. The Contractor shall provide housing, care, meals, and routine medical services for such inmates on the same basis as it provides for its own inmates confined in its own jail subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- MEDICAL SERVICES: The per day rate under this agreement covers only routine medical services such as on-site sick call (when provided by on-site staff) and non-prescription, over-the-counter/non-legend and routine drugs and medical supplies. The per day rate does not cover medical/health care services provided outside of the Contractor's facility or by other than facility staff, prescription drugs and treatments, or surgical, optical and dental care, and does not include the costs associated with any hospitalization of an inmate. The County shall pay the Contractor an amount equal to the amount the Contractor is required to expend for medical services other than those routine medical services provided for by the per day rate. When it becomes necessary for an inmate to be hospitalized, the Contractor shall contact the County, through its Sheriff or designated representative, as soon as possible to inform the County of the fact that the inmate has been, or is to be, hospitalized and of the nature of the illness or injury that has required the hospitalization.

The Contractor shall submit invoices for such medical services along with its regular monthly billings for detention services, and such invoices shall be paid on the same terms as the regular monthly billing.

It is understood and agreed that if the hospitalization of an inmate is to be for a duration of more than 24 hours, or the cost of any medical care or hospitalization is to exceed \$2,000.00, the Contractor has the right to arrange for the hospital or health care provider to bill the County directly for the costs of the hospitalization and/or medical care, rather than the Contractor paying the costs and billing the same to the County. If the hospital or health care provider refuses to bill the County directly, the County shall reimburse the Contractor for such costs within forty-five (45) business days of receipt of an invoice from

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the Contractor therefor, which invoice may be delivered personally, by facsimile, by mail or by other reliable courier.

- 1.03 <u>MEDICAL INFORMATION:</u> The County shall provide the Contractor with medical information for all inmates sought to be transferred to the Contractor's facility under this agreement, including information regarding any special medication, diet or exercise regiment applicable to each inmate.
- 1.04 TRANSPORTATION AND OFF-SITE SECURITY: The Contractor is solely responsible for the transportation of its inmates to and from the Contractor's facility. Ambulance transportation (including emergency flight, etc.) is not covered by the per day rate and will be billed along with the regular monthly billing submitted to the County by the Contractor.

Contractor will provide stationary guard services as requested or required by the circumstances or by law for inmates admitted or committed to an off-site medical facility. The County shall compensate the Contractor for the actual cost of said guard services to the Contractor, which shall be billed by the Contractor along with the regular monthly billing for detention services.

- 1.05 **SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** The per day rate set out in this agreement only covers basic custodial care and supervision and does not include any special educational, vocational or other programs. The parties may agree by a written amendment to this agreement, or by separate agreement, for the provision of special programs for the consideration and under the terms mutually agreed to by the parties.
- LOCATION AND OPERATION OF FACILITY: The Contractor shall provide the detention services described herein at the Lufkin Detention Center, 113 n. 2nd, Lufkin, Texas, which is operated by CiviGenics Texas, Inc.

ARTICLE II

FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

- 2.01 **PER DIEM RATE:** The per diem rate for detention services under this agreement is forty-two dollars (\$42.00) per man day. This rate covers one inmate per day. Any portion of any day shall count as a man-day under this agreement, except that the County may not be billed for two days when an inmate is admitted one evening and removed the following morning. In that situation, the Contractor will bill for the day of arrival, but not for the day of departure.
- 2.02 <u>BILLING PROCEDURE</u>: Contractor shall submit an itemized invoice for the services provided each month to the County, in arrears, invoices will be submitted to the officer of the County designated to receive the same on behalf of the County. The County shall make payment to the Contractor within thirty (30) days after receipt of the invoice. Payment shall be in the name of Angelina County, Texas and shall be remitted to:

Angelina County Auditor P.O. Box 7257 Lufkin, Texas 75901

Amounts which are not timely paid in accordance with the above procedure shall bear interest at the lesser of the annual percentage rate of 10%, or the maximum legal rate applicable thereto, which shall be a contractual obligation of the County under this agreement. County further agrees that the Contractor shall be entitled to recover its reasonable and necessary attorney's fees and costs incurred in collection of amounts due under this agreement.

ARTICLE III

TERM OF AGREEMENT

- 3.01 **PRIMARY TERM:** The primary term of this agreement is for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution of this agreement by both parties.
- 3.02 **RENEWALS:** This agreement maybe renewed annually by mutual agreement of the parties. In the event that the parties seek to renew this agreement at the end of the primary term or any renewal period, the per diem rate for detention services shall be at the rate negotiated by the parties for such renewal period. The terms, conditions and rates with regard to any renewal period shall be as mutually agreed between the parties, and as approved by the commissioners courts of the respective parties.
- 3.03 **TERMINATION:** This agreement shall terminate at the end of the primary term or of any renewal term unless renewed pursuant to Section 3.02. In addition, this agreement may be terminated upon sixty (60) days written notice by either party delivered to the officer specified herein by the other party to receive notices. This agreement will likewise terminate upon the happening of an event that renders performance hereunder by the Contractor impracticable or impossible, such as severe damage to or destruction of the facility or actions by governmental or judicial entities which create a legal barrier to the acceptance of any of the County's inmates.

ARTICLE IV

ACCEPTANCE OF INMATES

COMPLIANCE WITH LAW: Nothing herein shall create any obligation upon the formactor to house the County's inmates where the housing of said inmates will, in the opinion of the Contractor's Sheriff, raise the population of the facility above permissible numbers of inmates allowed by law, or will, in the Sheriff's opinion, create a condition of overcrowding or create conditions which endanger the life and/or welfare of personnel and inmates at the facility, or result in possible violation of the constitutional rights of the inmates housed at the facility. At any time that the Contractor's Sheriff determines that a condition exists at the Contractor's facility necessitating the removal of the County's prisoners, or any specified number thereof, the County shall, upon notice by the Contractor's Sheriff to the Sheriff of the County, immediately (within eight (8) hours) remove said prisoner from the facility.

4.02 <u>ELIGIBILITY FOR INCARCERATION AT FACILITY:</u> The only inmates of the County eligible for incarceration are those inmates eligible for incarceration in the facility in accordance with the state standards under both the Jail Commission approved custody assessment system in place at the County's jail and pursuant to the custody assessment system in place at the Contractor's facility.

All inmates proposed by the County to be transferred to the Contractor's facility under this agreement must meet the eligibility requirements set forth above. The Contractor reserves the right to review the inmates' classification/eligibility, and the right to refuse to accept any inmate that it does not believe to be properly classified as a non-high risk inmate. Furthermore, if an inmate's classification changes while incarcerated at the Contractor's facility, the Contractor reserves the right to demand that the County remove that inmate and replace said inmate with a non-high risk inmate of the County.

INCARCERATION OF INDIVIDUAL INMATES: Contractor reserves the right for its Sheriff or his designated representative to review the background of all inmates sought to be transferred to the Contractor's facility, and the County shall cooperate with and provide information requested regarding any inmate by the Contractor's Sheriff. The Contractor reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any prisoner of the County. Likewise, if any inmate's behavior, medical or psychological condition, or other circumstances of reasonable concern to the Contractor's Sheriff makes the inmate unacceptable for continued incarceration in Contractor's facility in the opinion of the Contractor's Sheriff, the county will be requested to remove said inmate from the facility, and shall do so immediately (within eight (8) hours) upon the request of the Contractor's Sheriff. Inmates may also be required to be removed from the facility when their classification changes for any purpose, including long-term medical segregation.

4.04 <u>INMATE SENTENCES:</u> Contractor shall not be in charge or responsible for the computation or processing of inmates time of confinement, including, but not limited to, computation of good time awards/credits and discharge dates. All such computations and recordkeeping shall continue to be the responsibility of the County. It shall be the responsibility of the County to notify the Contractor of any discharge date for an inmate at least ten (10) days before such date. The Contractor will release inmates of the County only when such release is specifically requested in writing by the Sheriff of the County. However, it is agreed that the preferred and usual course of dealing between the parties shall be for the County to pick up and return inmates to the County facility shortly before their discharge date, and for the County to discharge the inmate from its own facility. The County accepts all responsibility for the calculations and determinations set forth above and for giving Contractor notice of same, and to the extent allowed by law, shall indemnify and hold the Contractor harmless for all liability or expenses of any kind arising therefrom.

ARTICLE V

MISCELLANEOUS

5.01 <u>BINDING NATURE OF AGREEMENT:</u> This agreement is contractual and is binding upon the parties hereto and their successors, assigns, and representatives.

- 5.03 <u>AMENDMENTS:</u> This agreement shall not be modified or amended except by a written instrument executed by the duly authorized representatives of both parties and approved by commissioners courts of the respective parties hereto.
- 5.04 **PRIOR AGREEMENTS:** This agreement contains all of the agreements and undertakings, either oral or written, of the parties with respect to any matter mentioned herein. No prior agreement or understanding pertaining to any such matter shall be effective.
- 5.05 **CHOICE OF LAW AND VENUE:** The law which shall govern this agreement is the law of the State of Texas. All consideration to be paid and matters to be performed under this agreement are payable and performable in Lufkin, Angelina County, Texas, and venue of any dispute or matter arising under this agreement shall lie in a district court of Angelina County, Texas.
- 5.06 <u>APPROVALS:</u> This agreement must be approved by the Commissioners Court of the County and the Commissioners Court of the Contractor in accordance with the Interlocal Cooperation Act.
- 5.07 **FUNDING SOURCE:** The County must pay all amounts due under this agreement from current revenues available to it in accordance with the Interlocal Cooperation Act. The signature of the

County's Auditor below certifies that there are sufficient funds from current revenues available to the County to meet its obligations under this agreement.
