Brief Description:

The Task Force on Indigent Defense will provide resources to assist Polk County develop model forms for conducting the procurement of contract defenders in accordance with the newly adopted contract standards. The technical support will allow Polk County to reimburse legal fees and travel expenses. These expenses are for attorney(s) experienced in county law and indigent defense to develop processes and model forms to use in the establishment of contract defender systems in Polk County and other Texas counties.

Issue to Be Addressed:

In 2001 the Texas Legislature passed the Fair Defense Act. It gave the Task Force on Indigent Defense the authority to:

71.060(a) The Task Force on Indigent Defense shall develop policies and standards for providing legal representation and other defense services to indigent defendants at trial, on appeal, and in postconviction proceedings. The policies and standards may include:... establish rules (7) standards for providing indigent defense services under a contract defender program consistent with recognized national policies and standards;

On January 1, 2007 the new rules in Title 1, Chapter 174 of the Texas Administrative Code concerning contract defender systems will take effect for all Texas Counties. The Task Force staff has attempted to serve as a resource to the counties, but this is a new and undeveloped area for counties. A well qualified attorney experienced in county law and procedures, who is knowledgeable about indigent defense, is needed to develop a model set of processes and forms to assist local jurisdiction to implement the contract defender rules promulgated by the Task Force.

Proposed Project to Address Problem:

Polk County will procure through their normal attorney selection procedures an attorney or multiple attorneys to develop a model set of Request for Qualifications, an inter-local agreement, and a contract for service. The forms will be used to establish the Polk County Contract Defender System and be a resource for other Texas counties that choose to implement a contract defender program. The attorney(s) will develop a set of model

forms and procedures. The final product will include:

- 1) Checklist of steps indicated in Tx CCP 26.04 and Title 1, Chapter 174 of the Texas Administrative Code for contract defender systems
- 2) Model Request for Qualification (RFQ) Document
- 3) Procedure paper on issuing an RFQ and how to advertise.
- 4) Procedure paper on how to make the selection
- 5) Model contract for services of contract attorneys
- 6) Model Inter-local Agreement

The two Task Force staff that may provide assistance on the project are:

Bryan Wilson, Grants Administrator

Specific Assistance Needed from the Task Force:

Up to \$5000 for reimbursement of legal fees and travel expenses for attorney(s) to develop the actual documents Polk County will use in establishing its contract defender system as well as the model forms and recommended processes referenced above for the benefit of other Texas counties. The attorney(s) will be paid an amount agreed to by the county and the attorney(s) for legal services in accordance with the county's legal services procurement policy and any applicable state laws. The Task Force through this technical assistance will reimburse Polk County an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for actual expenses incurred. After the attorney(s) have been paid, the county will submit its total expenditures for the project, along with summary supporting documentation, to the budget analyst of the Task Force for reimbursement. The total amount may not exceed \$5,000. The county must provide the procedures, model forms and other documents to the Task Force prior to submission for reimbursement. Task Force staff attending meetings or reviewing documents will not be paid from these funds.

The estimated budget for this project is as follows: Legal fees and travel reimbursement \$5,000.

RETAINER AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made and entered into this 24th day of October , 2006, by and between Polk County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Client", and Allison, Bass & Associates, L.L.P. hereinafter referred to as "Attorneys".

Recitals

The Client is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. The Attorneys are duly licensed to practice law in the State of Texas and desire to render their professional services for the Client as provided herein.

THEREFORE, the Client hereby engages the services of the Attorneys, and in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

Services of Attorney

- 1. The Attorneys will advise and represent the Client in legal matters as requested by the Client, by and through a majority vote of the Commissioners Court, pertaining to the preparation of all necessary forms and documents to implement a Contract Defender Program for the Statutory County Court.
- 2. This Retainer Agreement shall serve as the basis for understanding regarding fees and costs to be charged to the Client, but the subject matter for legal services may only be authorized by an Order of the Commissioners Court.
- 3. Fees will include any and all necessary research, drafting and reviewing of documents, briefing, and consultation required for the proper disposition of any and all matters entrusted to the Attorneys pursuant to this retainer agreement.

Compensation

4. For the services described in Paragraph 1, the Client agrees to pay the Attorneys the sum of \$240.00 per hour for services rendered by partners of the firm and \$210.00 for services rendered by associates of the firm. The client will be billed at the rate of \$100.00 per hour for

services rendered by any paralegal of the firm. A travel time fee of \$50.00 per hour will be charged for all time actually in transit, in lieu of any hourly charge normally attributed to the timekeeper. The Client will also be billed for all direct out-of-pocket expenses including travel expenses, telephone, photocopy, facsimile costs, reports, studies, and exhibits incurred by Attorneys in this matter. Attorneys will provide Client with an itemized billing each month stating services rendered. Total billing will not exceed \$5,000.00 without additional Client approval.

Devotion of Time

5. The Attorney shall make themselves available for consultation with the Client at reasonable times, at the request of the Client.

Term

6. This agreement shall be effective on the execution hereof by Client and shall continue in effect until the matter has been finally concluded or upon 30 days written notice by either party. The Client shall send notice to the Attorneys' office at 402 West 12th Street, Austin, Texas 78701, and the Attorneys shall send notice to the Client care of County Judge, Polk County Courthouse, 101 West Church Street, Ste. 300, Livingston, Texas 77351.

Prior Agreements Superseded

7. This agreement constitutes the sole and only agreement of the parties hereto and supersedes any prior understandings or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting the within subject matter.
