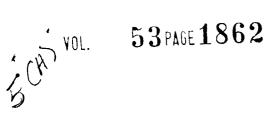

## RESOLUTION EXPRESSING INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES TO BE INCURRED BY POLK COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Polk County, Texas (the "Issuer") is a Texas County and a political subdivision of the State of Texas authorized to issue obligations to finance its activities pursuant to various Texas statutes, including anticipation notes pursuant to Chapter 1431, Texas Government Code, the interest on which is excludable from gross income for federal income tax purposes ("tax-exempt obligations") pursuant to Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code");

WHEREAS, the Issuer will make, or has made not more than 60 days prior to the date hereof, payments from funds from interfund transfers, as authorized by Section 1431.005, Texas Government Code, with respect to the acquisition, construction, repair and equipping of the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the Issuer has concluded that it does not currently desire to issue tax-exempt obligations to finance the costs associated with the projects listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto;

## POLK COUNTY INDIGENT HEALTHCARE PROGRAM MANDATED MEDICAL PROVIDER APPOINTMENT

The Polk County Commissioners Court elects to appoint Americare-EMS (Provider) as a designated emergency care provider for County Inmates and shall provide emergency medically necessary services as deemed appropriate. This agreement is for the provision of emergency services.

#### T. SCOPE of SERVICES

The "Provider" agrees to provide Emergency Medical Service to jail inmates as deemed necessary when dispatched by the Polk County Jail staff. Based upon the decision by the EMS personnel and/or the Jail Medical Physician, the "Provider" will transfer the patient to the nearest available facility who will provide the appropriate medically necessary services, ensuring quality of care.

In the event the Contractual Provider is unable to respond to a dispatched call, the Provider will contact another available qualified Emergency Medical Service to provide evaluation, treatment and/or transport.

### II. **Compensation for Services**

Polk County Commissioners Court shall reimburse the "Provider" as follows: a. Non-transport-\$100.00; transport-\$165.00 and \$9.25 per mile (no minimum mileage charge).

### Relationship and Indemnification of Parties III.

- The relationship of the parties under this Agreement is solely that of independent a. contractors. Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute, be construed to, or create a partnership, joint venture, or employment relationship between the parties hereto or any of their contractors.
- County and Provider, to the extent authorized under the Texas Constitution and a. Texas laws, without limitation, Chapter 102, Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, agree to hold each party, its officers, employees, and agents harmless from and indemnify each of them against any and all claims, actions, damages, suits, Proceedings, judgments, and liabilities for personal injury, death, or property damage resulting from the acts or omissions of County or Provider or others

under County's and Provider's supervision or control, and the acts of God, material or labor restriction by any governmental authority, civil riot, floods, hurricanes, or other natural disasters, and any other cause not reasonably within the control of County or Provider and which by the exercise of due diligence of County and/or Provider is unable, wholly or in part, to prevent or overcome.

c. "Provider" and staff shall uphold requirements of the Federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) and the Privacy Rule published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services at 45 CFR 160-164 (Privacy Rule). HIPAA and the Rule regulate the services of protected health information.

## V. TERM AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

- a. **Term.** This agreement will commence upon the date executed by both parties and remain in full force and effective for a period of twelve months and automatically renew subsequently in twelve months term—unless terminated as provided herein. This agreement supercedes all previous agreements.
- b. **Optional Termination.** In the event either party, with or without cause, at any time, shall give to the other party at least 30 (thirty) days advance written notice. This agreement shall terminate on the future date specified in such notice.
- c. **Notice.** Any notice, demand or communication required, permitted or desired to be given hereunder shall be deemed effectively given when personally delivered or mailed by prepaid certified mail addressed to either party and copied to the Director of Polk County Indigent Health Care.

# THIRD AMENDMENT AND EXTENSION OF LEASE AGREEMENT

## THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM

This Third Amendment and Extension of Lease Agreement ("Amendment") is entered into by and between POLK COUNTY ("Lessor") and the BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM, for the use and benefit of The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston ("Lessee"), effective as of May 1, 2007.

## **RECITALS**

- A. Effective May 17, 1996, Lessor and Lessee entered into that Lease Agreement (the "Lease") having a term commencing effective December 1, 1995, and ending on November 30, 1996, wherein Lessor leased to Lessee and Lessee leased from Lessor approximately 10,524 net usable square feet of space in the Polk County Regional Health Center located at 410 East Church Street in the City of Livingston, Polk County, Texas, as more specifically described in the lease.
- B. Lessor and Lessee subsequently amended the original Lease by a First Amendment dated December 1, 1996, which extended the term of the Lease to provide for expiration on November 30, 2001. Lessor and Lessee subsequently amended the original Lease by a Second Amendment dated November 1, 2001, which extended the term of the Lease to provide for expiration on November 30, 2006. Lessor and Lessee extended the original lease month-to-month by Letter dated November 9, 2006, which extended the term of the Lease until this Third Amendment is effective as of May 1, 2007.
- C. Lessor and Lessee wish to modify the Lease to extend the term of the Lease and to enter into this Amendment to evidence the extension of the Lease as provided herein.

## **AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the terms and conditions set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Lessor and Lessee hereby agree to amend the Lease as follows:

- 1. Extension of Lease Term. The term of the Lease is extended for an additional period commencing May 1, 2007 and ending on December 31, 2011, unless sooner terminated as provided in the Lease. Lessor and Lessee agree that execution of this Amendment by both parties is effective to extend the term, and any other conditions for extension contained in the Lease are hereby waived for the purposes of this renewal term. Following the extension of the term pursuant to this Amendment, any additional extensions of the term shall be governed by the provisions of the Lease.
- 2. Property Leased. The square feet of net usable space is reduced from 10,524 square feet 4,330 to 4,521 square feet. A revised Exhibit A of the floor plan is attached hereto. Lessor and Lessee approximately acknowledge that Lessee also occupies 3,165 square feet under a separate lease agreement.
- 3. <u>Monthly Rental.</u> Lessor will pay Lessor a rental of not more than TWO HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$250.00), per month during the term commencing May 1, 2007 and ending on December 31, 2011.
- 4. <u>Ratification and Defined Terms</u>. Except as amended or modified by this Amendment, the Lease shall continue in full force and effect as therein provided and the Lease is hereby ratified in all respects by Lessor and Lessee. Except as otherwise defined in this Amendment, each of the terms used herein shall have the same meaning assigned to such terms in the Lease.

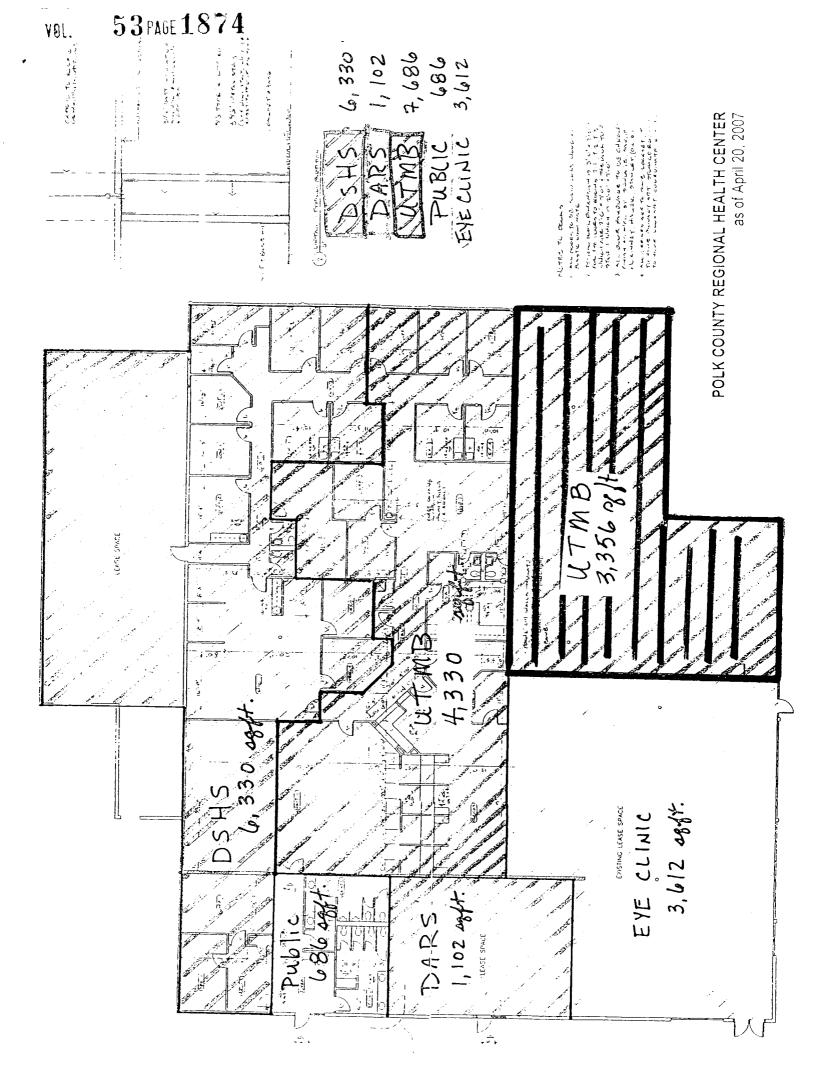

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH BANCORPSOUTH EQUIPMENT FINANCE, A DIVISION OF BANCORPSOUTH BANK.

WHEREAS, Commissioner's Court (the "Governing Body") of Polk County, Texas ("Lessee"), acting for and on behalf of Lessee hereby finds, determines and adjudicates as follows:

- 1. Lessee desires to enter into an Equipment Lease Purchase Agreement with the Exhibits attached thereto in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Agreement") with BancorpSouth Equipment Finance, a division of BancorpSouth Bank ("Lessor") for the purpose of presently leasing with an option to purchase the equipment as described therein for the total cost specified therein (collectively the "Equipment").
- 2. It is in the best interest of the public purposes of Lessee that Lessee lease with an option to purchase the Equipment pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of the Agreement; and
  - 3. It is necessary for Lessee to approve and authorize the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Governing Body for and on behalf of Lessee as follows:

- Section 1. The Agreement and Exhibits attached thereto, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit "A", by and between Lessor and Lessee are hereby approved, and John Thompson, Co.Judge (the "Authorized Officer") is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of Lessee.
  - Section 2. The Delivery Order is being issued in calendar year 2007.
- Section 3. Neither any portion of the gross proceeds of the Agreement nor the Equipment identified in the Agreement shall be used (directly or indirectly) in a trade or business carried on by any person other than a governmental unit, except for such use as a member of the general public.
- Section 4. No portion of the rental payments identified in the Agreement: (a) is secured, directly or indirectly, by property used or to be used in a trade or business carried on by a person other than a governmental unit, except for such use as a member of the general public, or by payments in respect of such property; or (b) is to be derived from payments (whether or not to Lessee) in respect of property or borrowed money used or to be used for a trade or business carried on by any person other than a governmental unit.

Section 5. No portion of the gross proceeds of the Agreement are used (directly or indirectly) to make or finance loans to persons other than governmental units.

Section 6. the Authorized Officer is further authorized for and on behalf of the Governing Body and Lessee to do all things necessary in furtherance of the obligations of Lessee pursuant to the Agreement, including execution and delivery of all other documents Necessary or appropriate to carry out the transactions contemplated thereby in accordance with the terms and provisions thereof:

## **General Instructions**

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

## Purpose of Form

Form 8038-GC is used by the issuers of tax-exempt governmental obligations to provide the IRS with the information required by section 149(e) and to monitor the requirements of sections 141 through 150.

#### Who Must File

Issuers of tax-exempt governmental obligations with issue prices of less than \$100,000 must file Form 8038-GC.

Issuers of a tax-exempt governmental obligation with an issue price of \$100,000 or more must file Form 8038-G, Information Return for Tax-Exempt Governmental Obligations.

Filing a separate return. Issuers have the option to file a separate Form 8038-GC for any tax-exempt governmental obligation with an issue price of less than \$100,000.

An issuer of a tax-exempt bond used to finance construction expenditures must file a separate Form 8038-GC for each issue to give notice to the IRS that an election was made to pay a penalty in lieu of arbitrage rebate (see the line 12 instructions).

Filing a consolidated return. For all tax-exempt governmental obligations with issue prices of less than \$100,000 that are not reported on a separate Form 8038-GC, an issuer must file a consolidated information return including all such issues issued within the calendar year.

Thus, an issuer may file a separate Form 8038-GC for each of a number of small issues and report the remainder of small issues issued during the calendar year on one consolidated Form 8038-GC. However, a separate Form 8038-GC must be filed to give the IRS notice of the election to pay a penalty in licu of arbitrage rebate.

### When To File

To file a separate return, file Form 8038-GC on or before the 15th day of the second calendar month after the close of the calendar quarter in which the issue is issued.

To file a consolidated return, file Form 8038-GC on or before February 15th of the calendar year following the year in which the issue is issued.

Late filing. An issuer may be granted an extension of time to file Form 8038-GC under Section 3 of Rev. Proc. 88-10, 1988-1 C.B. 635, if it is determined that the failure to file on time is not due to willful neglect. Type or print at the top of the form, "This Statement Is Submitted in Accordance with Rev. Proc. 88-10." Attach to the Form 8038-GC a letter briefly stating why the form was not submitted to the IRS on time. Also indicate whether the obligation in question is under examination by the IRS. Do not submit copies of any bond documents, leases, or installment sale documents. See Where To File below

## Where To File

File Form 8038-GC, and any attachments, with the Internal Revenue Service Center, Ogden, UT 84201.

## Other Forms That May Be Required

For rebating arbitrage (or paying a penalty in lieu of arbitrage rebate) to the Federal government, use Form 8038-T, Arbitrage Rebate and Penalty in Lieu of Arbitrage Rebate. For private activity bonds, use Form 8038, Information Return for Tax-Exempt Private Activity Bond Issues.

#### Rounding to Whole Dollars

You may show the money items on this return as whole-dollar amounts. To do so, drop any amount less than 50 cents and increase any amount from 50 to 99 cents to the next higher dollar.

#### **Definitions**

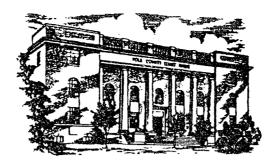
Obligations. This refers to a single tax-exempt governmental obligation if Form 8038-GC is used for separate reporting or to multiple tax-exempt governmental obligations if the form is used for consolidated reporting.

Tax-exempt obligation. This is a bond, installment purchase agreement, or financial lease, on which the interest is excluded from income under section 103.

Tax-exempt governmental obligation. A tax-exempt obligation that is not a private activity bond (see below) is a tax-exempt governmental obligation. This includes a bond issued by a qualified volunteer fire department under section 150(e).

Private activity bond. This includes an obligation issued as part of an issue in which:

 More than 10% of the proceeds are to be used for any private activity business use, and
