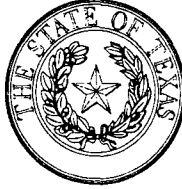

MEMORANDUM

**DATE:** August 18, 2008  
**RE:** General Election Duties

One of your official election-related duties for the November 4, 2008 general election is to order the election. You must order the general election for county and precinct offices not later than August 26, 2008. The Governor will order the general election for state and district offices to be held on November 4, 2008.

You are required to give notice of this election by publishing the notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the county between October 5, 2008 and October 27, 2008 (deadline extended). You may also give notice by posting a copy of the notice in a public place in each election precinct not later than October 14, 2008 or by mailing the notice to each registered voter in the county not later than October 27, 2008 (deadline extended).

You are also required to post a notice on the bulletin board used for posting open meetings notices of commissioners court meetings not later than October 14, 2008. In addition, you must also mail writs of election to each election judge no later than October 20, 2008.

You are required to certify any independent or write-in candidates to the County Clerk/Elections Administrator no later than September 3, 2008. The deadline for write-in candidates to file with you for county and precinct offices is August 26, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. There are forms for these certifications in our Forms Manual, which is now online at <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/forms/index.shtml>, forms AW3-13 and AW3-14. You do not have to use our form. If no write-in candidates filed, you must certify that fact by stating "none" on Form AW3-14.

The commissioners court **must** canvass the general election between Wednesday, November 12, 2008 and Monday, November 17, 2008.
