**Supporting to Grant Application to U.S. Department of Justice,
Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (BFY 09)**

For Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation

WHEREAS, it is found to be in the best interest of the citizens of Polk County that the Justice Assistance Grant Program Local Solicitation (BFY 09); and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court agrees to provide for the said project as required by the Office of U.S. Department of Justice (BFY09) grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of U.S. Department of Justice funds, Polk County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of U.S. Department of Justice Services in full; and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court designates Sheriff of Polk County as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency, upon notification to the Commissioners Court.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Polk County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (BFY 09) to the U.S. Department of Justice Services.
