WHEREAS, The Commissioner's Court of Polk County, Texas finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Polk County, Texas and that the Juvenile Probation Department Mental Health Services and Technology Project be operated from September 1, 2010 until August 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner's Court of Polk County, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, The Commissioner's Court of Polk County, Texas assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.
