Designating Surplus/Salvage Property to be offered for sale at Public Auction

WHEREAS, in a regular meeting of the Polk County Commissioners Court held September 28, 2010, the following has been determined to be property owned by the county, other than items routinely discarded as waste, that because of use, time, accident, or any other cause is so worn, damaged, or obsolete that it has no value for the purpose for which it was originally intended;


Road & Bridge Precinct 2 miscellaneous scrap metal, including salvage equipment attachments.

THEREFORE, the aforementioned items are hereby designated as Salvage Property of the County, as defined by Local Government Code, Chapter 263 Subchapter D, Section 263.152, and shall be offered for sale at public auction.

FURTHER, should the property described herein fail to receive a bid at public auction, this Court hereby grants authority to the County Auditor and County Commissioner, Precinct 2 to mutually determine disposal of said property in the best interest of the County
