
**WHEREAS,** the Polk County Commissioners Court agrees to provide 12 month found for the said project as required by the *COPS Rehiring Program* grant application; and



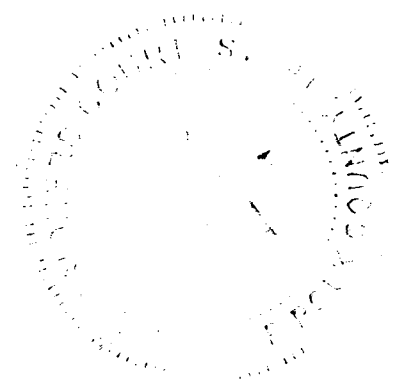
