

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF POLK, TEXAS, REQUESTING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ACCEPT AND PLACE INDUSTRIAL ROAD AND PLANT ROAD ON THE STATE FARM-TO-MARKET HIGHWAY SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Polk County recognizes the importance of a quality transportation system and its importance to the economy of Texas and the United States; and,

WHEREAS, Polk County recognizes the importance of transportation for a prosperous economy and industrial Road and Plant Road serves a wood products company that is a major employer for both Polk County and the East Texas Region; and,

WHEREAS, Polk County desires to improve Industrial Road and Plant Road to enhance future industrial development; and,

WHEREAS, Polk County and the City of Corrigan propose to upgrade these established roads, to comply with the Texas Department of Transportation design standards and specifications, at no expense to the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, Polk County is in agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation accepting control, jurisdiction and maintenance of the currently designated routes Industrial Road and Plant Road upon completion of these upgrades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF POLK COUNTY, TEXAS that the County Judge is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation to upgrade Industrial Road and Plant Road, in accordance with all state and federal specifications and applicable laws for inclusion on the State Farm-to-Market Highway System.
