ORDER

Authorizing and Assigning space in County-owned Buildings

WHEREAS, Counties are permitted and encouraged to provide space in county-owned buildings to private and other entities which serve as agents of the public and which promote or carry out a county purpose; and,

WHEREAS, such entities have requested office space which is available within certain county-owned buildings and this Court finds that the provision of space to the requesting entities will serve a county purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

That the Commissioners Court of Polk County, Texas hereby authorizes and assigns the use of space located in the county-owned building referenced herein to the following entities:

Polk County Office Annex – 602 E. Church – Livingston, Texas;

SAAFE House, Red Cross, Lower Trinity Groundwater Conservation District, DETCOG Homeland Security, Experience Works, Texas Agri-Life Extension, DPS Weights & Measures, Texas Ranger, CERT, CASA, Southeast Texas Regional Advisory Council (SETRAC).

Polk County Law Enforcement Center – 1733 N. Washington – Livingston, Texas
Texas Department of Public Safety, Texas Parks & Wildlife (Game Wardens)

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the County shall not charge a fee to the listed entities for the use of said space/s.
