BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners Court of Polk County convened in a regularly called session on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2014 in the Commissioners Courtroom of the Polk County Courthouse in Livingston, Texas with the following Members present and representing a quorum; John P.
