



WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Polk County, Texas that the *Juvenile-At-Risk Diversion Program* be operated for the FY2015; and

WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court agrees to provide no matching funds for the said project as required by the Criminal Justice Division grant application; and

WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, Polk County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court designates John Thompson, County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Polk County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the *Juvenile-At-Risk Diversion Program* to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
