DOCUMENTATION OF EXEMPTION

Dear Mr. Purvis,

In reference to the above and pursuant to the "Polk County, Texas Subdivision Regulations", please be advised of the following;

- All of the "Southern Star" tracts are above 10 acres:
- Each tract is directly and individually accessed by existing public roads with frontage exceeding 30 feet;
- All tracts are to be serviced by private sewer systems as public sewer is not available;
- In addition, there are to be no common areas or new streets dedicated to Polk County, Texas;
- We acknowledge that all tracts will comply with the minimum building setbacks from major highways and public roads, as described in Sections 8.1 through 8.3 and A.5 of the Polk County, Texas Subdivision Regulations; and
- Lots will be serviced by Nigton-Wakefield WSC (where available) or by private water wells.

As required by Section A.18(a) of the Polk County, Texas Subdivision Regulations, we affirm these fact to be correct and request an exemption by the Polk County Commissioners Court to exclude the nine (9) tracts of Southern Star Subdivision described herein from engineering and platting requirements of Polk County.


