
OF THE POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

Designating Surplus/Salvage Property and Disposition thereof

WHEREAS, in a regular meeting of the Polk County Commissioners Court held April 24, 2018 certain item/s as listed on Asset Management Forms attached hereto attached hereto as Exhibit "A" were determined to be surplus/salvage property as defined by Local Government Code, Chapter 263 Subchapter D, Section 263.151;

THEREFORE, the aforementioned item/s listed on Exhibit "A" of this Order are hereby designated as Surplus/Salvage Property of the County and shall be disposed of either in a Public Auction to be held online by the County's contracted auctioneer and administered by the County Auditor or by competitive bid;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that any or all of the property listed on Exhibit "A" of this Order may be destroyed as worthless if the County undertakes to sell that property (by public auction) and is unable to do so because no bids are made or the property is unclaimed by a successful bidder for a period of thirty (30) days following the close of the auction. In this instance, the Auditor shall properly note such disposition for each item so destroyed.

For your information and record, I have attached a copy of the Commissioners Court Order approved on April 24, 2018 to designate certain property held by the Permit/Inspection Office and Road & Bridge, Precinct 3 (described in the Order's Exhibit) as surplus property of the County.

The (computer/software) property has been reviewed by I.T. and found not to be useful to another office and all computer memory has been cleared. These items may be picked up and stored by the Maintenance Department for the next on-line County Auction.

The RB3 Vehicles will be photographed by Precinct 3, who will coordinate descriptions and inspection dates for listing in the County's next public (on-line) auction. The Precinct 3 scrap metal and culverts will be advertised locally for competitive bidding.

The Order includes language to allow for the destruction of any property which is 1) unsold because no bids are received, or 2) unclaimed by a successful bidder within 30 days following the close of the public auction.
