ORDER

Authorizing and Assigning space in County-owned Buildings

WHEREAS, such entities have requested office space which is available within certain county-owned buildings and this Court finds that the provision of space to the requesting entities will serve a county purpose;

<u>Onalaska Sub-Courthouse – 501 E Hwy 190 Onalaska, Texas</u> Allegiance Ambulance

<u>Precinct 3 (LeBlanc Building) – 912 S. Home Corrigan, Texas</u> Corrigan Christian Resource Center (Food Distribution)

James J. "Buddy" Purvis Health & Human Services Building – Corrigan, Texas Corrigan Heritage Society (storage)

<u>Dunbar Complex – 1112 Dogwood Livingston, Texas</u> Greater East Texas Community Action
