

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

By and Between POLK COUNTY, TEXAS And THE CITY OF ONALASKA, TEXAS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, on or about the 7th day of October 2019, an agreement related to permitting and inspection of septic systems and the fees charged therefore, was entered into by and between the COUNTY OF POLK, STATE OF TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as County, acting by and through its duly elected Commissioners Court, and the CITY OF ONALASKA, TEXAS, a City located within Polk County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as City, acting by and through its duly elected Mayor and City Council; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to supplement the aforementioned agreement, and it is hereby agreed by the governing bodies of the County and the CITY that the consideration in support of this agreement is the exchange of services as herein contemplated, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and undertakings hereinafter described, it is agreed:

 The COUNTY agrees to permit and inspect all on-site septic facilities within the CITY, including but not limited, to evaluating septic systems.

- 2. The CITY agrees to comply with all present or future laws pertaining to the inspection and approval of on-site septic facilities within the State of Texas, including minimum state standards.
- 3. The **COUNTY** shall enforce reasonable rules and regulations in the conduct of its business, provided that such regulations, including rights and charges, shall be subject to the approval of the **CITY**, as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
 - 4. The CITY agrees to notify the County of the installation of on-site septic systems, and of all on-site septic systems which need inspecting.
 - 5. The COUNTY will charge the same rate that it charges for outside the CITY limits. for each permit issued for septic systems within the CITY, and shall be solely responsible for collecting such charges from the customers.
 - 6. Both parties in this agreement clearly understand and agree that it is the intent of all parties for the on-site septic facilities of the CITY to operate fully and completely in compliance with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations concerning waste disposal, and both parties will use their best efforts to ensure continued compliance with all laws and regulations.
