
**Designating Surplus/Salvage Property to be Donated to  
Emergency Food and Shelter Programs**


WHEREAS, in a regular meeting of the Polk County Commissioners Court held June 9, 2020, those items listed on "Exhibit A", were determined to be surplus property as defined by Local Government Code, Chapter 263 Sub chapter D, Section 263.151, consisting of cubicles removed from county buildings and replaced with new cubicles, as listed on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

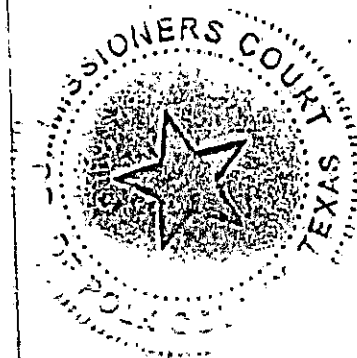
FURTHERMORE, pursuant to Local Government Code, Section 263.152(a)(4); The commissioners court finds that the Emergency Food and Shelter Programs are qualified organizations to which the County may donate the property and the Court finds that: (A) the items did not sell at the online auction; (B) the donation serves a public purpose; and (C) the receiving organization will provide the county with adequate consideration;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, that the Commissioners Court approves the donation of the property listed on Exhibit A attached hereto to the Emergency Food and Shelter Programs for installation at the locations

FURTHER, Polk County recognizes that the transport and proper installation of the donated fixtures is the sole responsibility of the Emergency Food and Shelter Programs.
