

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF POLK COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE COMMITMENT OF LOCAL COUNTY FUNDS AND PARTICIPATION IN A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT MITIGATION (CDBG-MIT) PROJECT BY THE DEEP EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (DETCOG) FOR REGIONWIDE INTEROPERABLE RADIO COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Polk County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities; and


WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Polk County to commit local funds and participate in the DETCOG Regionwide Interoperable Radio Communications Infrastructure Project under the Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program administered by the Texas General Land Office;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF POLK COUNTY, TEXAS:
