



**RESOLUTION
OF THE POLK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT**

Supporting Continued Participation in the
Texas Countywide Polling Place Program

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Election Code §43.007 et. seq., Texas counties which have been approved by the Texas Secretary of State to participate in a program to use countywide polling places for elections and have conducted at least one election under this plan may apply to the Secretary of State to continue use of countywide polling places for elections as an alternative to having a polling location in each county election precinct; and

WHEREAS, Polk County successfully conducted such an election on November 2, 2021; under this program; and


WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court held a public hearing on April 13, 2021 regarding the County's participation in the program, and has submitted an electronic recording of the hearing to the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court finds it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Polk County to continue to participate in the Secretary of State's Countywide Polling Place Program in future elections.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

THAT the Polk County Commissioners Court supports the Application to receive a "Successful Status" designation by the Texas Secretary of State allowing it to continue to participate in the Countywide Polling Place Program as provided in Election Code § 43.007 et.seq.






