

JP#4 JAMIE RICHARDSON DISCUSSED ISSUES WITH HER COURTROOM AND STATED IF THE REGIONAL HEALTH BUILDING WAS MOVED OUT OF HER PRECINCT THEN SHE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO UTILIZE THE BUILDING FOR JURY TRIALS. HER OWN COURTROOM IS NOT LARGE ENOUGH TO HOLD THEM. ERIC MAGEE, OF ALLISON, BASS, AND MAGEE (THE COUNTY'S LEGAL COUNSEL FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDISTRICTING) ADVISED THAT, BECAUSE THE REGIONAL HEALTH BUILDING IS ON THE PRECINCT BORDER AND NO ONE LIVES WITHIN THIS BLOCK, WE COULD CUT THIS BLOCK OUT OF PRECINCT THREE AND KEEP IT IN PRECINCT 4. THAT WILL BE INCLUDED IN EXHIBIT 3 ATTACHED TO THE ORDER ADOPTING THE REDISTRICTING PLAN.
