

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that all interest of the Defendant in the above-described property, is hereby forfeited to the State of Texas, namely, Polk County Constable Precinct 1, and is subject to disposition under Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, and the terms of the interlocal agreement between that agency and the Brazoria County Criminal District Attorney's Office.

It is further ORDERED that the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue good and sufficient title to the forfeited property identified above that will perfect title in Polk County Constable Precinct 1 and any subsequent purchaser from that agency.

It is further ORDERED that all costs are assessed against the party incurring the same. This judgment is final, disposes of all claims and all parties, and is appealable. The Court orders execution to issue for this judgment.




