**Order Designating Temporary Location of Sheriff's/Tax Sales  
Effective August 10, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the majestic but aged courthouse located at 101 West Church Street, Livingston Texas 77351 shall undergo extensive historic restoration beginning July 6, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, said restoration shall be completed more efficiently and cost effectively only upon complete vacancy of said premises; and

**WHEREAS**, all Polk County governmental offices must continue to perform their essential functions so vital to the health and welfare of the citizenry during said renovation; and

**WHEREAS**, these Polk County governmental offices and courts, include, but are not limited to the County Constitutional Court, County Judge and the County Clerk; and


**WHEREAS**, the Polk County Commissioner's Court has established, by order, facilities to temporarily house all Sheriff's/Tax sales of foreclosed property, said facilities being located at 1103 Dunbar Avenue, Livingston, Texas 77351; and

**WHEREAS**, it will be in the county's best interest to relocate all aforesaid tax sales to said locations; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the above-referenced sales shall be conducting business of the county and the State of Texas forthwith at 1103 Dunbar Avenue, Livingston Texas 77351, said move being effective August 10, 2022:

**AND FURTHER** all business lawfully conducted at the original Courthouse location shall thence forward be properly conducted at the temporary location, including, but not limited to: all Sheriff's sales of foreclosed properties, **UNTIL FURTHER ORDER OF THIS COURT. IT IS SO ORDERED.**
