ORDER TO ESTABLISH ANNUAL APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR ENROLLING CHARITABLE ENTITIES IN THE JUROR DONATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Section 61.003 of the Government Code was amended by the provisions of SB 1264 on September 1, 2017, relating to certain Juror Donations; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk is required to include on their Juror Donation Form, compensation to victims of crime fund under Subchapter B, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure; the child welfare, child protective services, or child services board of the county appointed under Section 264.005, Family Code, that serves abused and neglected children; any other program approved by the commissioners' court of the county, including a program established under Article 56.04(f), Code of Criminal Procedure, that offers psychological counseling in criminal cases involving graphic evidence or testimony; or a veterans court program established by the commissioners court as provided by Chapter 124.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. All new requests must be submitted by December 15 to be included on in the jury donation program beginning in January of the new year. The new charity shall submit a sworn request stating the organization's current existence and non-profit status along with a copy of their 501-C approval, to the District Clerk of Polk County for approval by Commissioners Court.
- 2. The District Clerk shall be notified within 30 days of any change concerning an organization's existence and non-profit status; otherwise the organization will remain in the jury donation program until the District Clerk is notified.
