ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3

AN ORDINANCE OF POLK COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF GLOVER ROAD AND FRANK ROAD RAILROAD CROSSINGS

WHEREAS, the northern entrance of Glover Road is located at the north end of Loop 116 and travels south approximately 1.00686 miles in Polk County; and

WHEREAS, the southern entrance to Frank Drive is located northeast of Glover Road and the road travels northwest for approximately .30437 miles to FM 942 in Polk County; and

WHEREAS, the Polk County Commissioners recognizes the safety of its homeowners during railroad construction, closing the roads to motor vehicles in order to protect the citizens, prevent motorists from becoming stranded, and to preserve the roads for recreational purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Polk County ordains closing the above mentioned railroad crossings as follows, contingent on Union Pacific Rail Road and Texas Department of Transportation funding of the project:

This Ordinance shall be effective as of May 16th, 2023.
