## Order Designating Exemption from Inscription Requirement for Certain Vehicles operated by the District Attorney's Office

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office of Polk County maintains a vehicle inventory to carry out official duties: and

WHEREAS, Section 721.005(b)(1)(e) of the Texas Transportation Code provides the authority for a county to exempt an automobile from the inscription requirement when used to perform official duties by a district attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Ford Escape and 2023 Nissan Rogue, currently included in the District Attorney's vehicle inventory, have been identified as essential assets for the efficient functioning of the District Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate a person to apply for license plates for the aforementioned vehicles;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF POLK **COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:**

- 1. Pursuant to Section 721.005(b)(1)(e) of the Texas Transportation Code, the 2022 Ford Escape, and 2023 Nissan Rogue, currently included in the District Attorney's vehicle inventory, are hereby exempted from the inscription requirement for county-owned motor vehicles.
- 2. The exemption granted in Point 1 is solely applicable to the official use of the aforementioned vehicles by the District Attorney's Office.
- 3. Stephanie Dale, Assistant to the County Auditor, is hereby designated as the authorized person to apply for license plates on behalf of the District Attorney's Office for the exempted vehicles mentioned in Point 1.
- 4. This exemption order shall take effect immediately and remain in force until rescinded or modified by the Commissioners Court of Polk County, Texas, or until the vehicles are removed from the District Attorney's vehicle inventory.
- This order shall be filed in the Commissioners Court Minutes and published in 5. accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
