The Polk County Auditor's Office ensures transparency in the county's finances. The office's mission is to safeguard the County's Assets, process and pay valid County financial obligations and assist the county in running its operations in a regulatory compliant and efficient manner. The Auditor's Office makes sure required financial documentation to federal, state and other oversight organizations is verified and submitted.

The Auditor Department is a five-person team comprised of County Auditor, Assistant to the County Auditor and three Assistant Auditors. They work with all parts of county government. The Auditor's Office works closely with elected officials and departments as well as outside agencies and vendors to facilitate statutory compliance and to determine whether taxpayer dollars are being utilized in a responsible and ethical way.

In addition, the Auditor's Office is also responsible for the following:

Review, approve, process all valid County payment liabilities, then provide those processed liabilities to Commissioners Court for their final approval before release of payment

Handle financial and compliance reporting to include monthly, quarterly and annual financial reporting, Securities and Exchange Commission and OPEB reporting and provide/manage financial data to independent auditor for annual audit

Manage financial aspects of grant funding to include billing, cash receipts, reconciliation of grant programs, compliance requirements and provide financial information for grant projects that are audited by outside agencies

Manage insurance requirements for liability, property and vehicles and vehicle title work and registrations

Manage financial aspects of leased vehicles

Provide and manage financial information for County yearly Tax Note borrowing
Record and report financial information required by Juvenile and Adult Probation
Departments and provide/manage financial data to independent auditor for annual audits

Compile and provide information to be utilized by the Tax Collector – Assessor for the yearly budget process
