SART Protocols

Victim goes to hospital

- Hospital calls hotline for Crisis Intervention Advocate and calls Law Enforcement
- Victim Assistance Coordinator is notified
- CPS is notified if a child is involved
- APS is notified if an elderly person is involved

Victim calls hotline or comes into the office

- Crisis Intervention Advocate contacts hospital
 - o Hospital contacts Law Enforcement
 - o Hospital contacts SANE
- As situation warrants Crisis Intervention Advocate contacts Law Enforcement when victim is 17 years old and under or the victim is 65 years and over
- CPS is notified if child is involved
- APS is notified if an elderly person is involved

Victim calls 911

- Law Enforcement calls hotline for Crisis Intervention Advocate and hospital
- Advocate calls Law Enforcement back to confirm
- CPS is notified if a child is involved
- APS is notified if an elderly person is involved

Contact with each agency should be made within 30 minutes so that all agencies can have an appropriate response time to the victim
