WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Polk County, that the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program be operated for years 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, Polk County Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said projects as required by the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant applications; and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor's funds, Polk County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, The Polk County Commissioners Court designates Honorable Sydney Murphy, County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grants on behalf of the applicant agency, upon notification to the Commissioners Court.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Polk County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant applications for the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program to the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Division.
