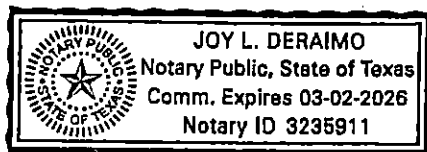



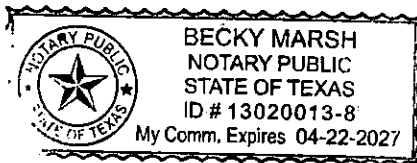
### ANNUAL ROAD REPORT

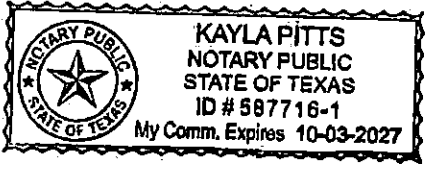
